

FISH OUT OF WATER!



**It's your river, take care of it.
Keep river water in the river.**

Using the river to water your lawn raises water temperatures and lowers water levels making it difficult for fish to survive.

- A state authorized water right is required to use water from any creek or river.
- Creek or river withdrawals create water shortages.

Water conservation tips:

- Water your plants deeply but less frequently to encourage deep roots.
- Consider xeriscaping or using native plants to reduce your water use.
- Use 2 to 4 inches of mulch around plants to reduce evaporation.
