Clark County Charter Review Commission Meeting Ground rules

- 1. Be prepared and be on time
- 2. Identify yourself the first time you speak
- 3. Speak slowly and clearly
- 4. Be alert and actively listen during discussions, avoid distractions to others in your background.
- 5. Commissioners are to be present on camera, exemptions for poor internet connection issues.
- 6. Commissioners and meeting attendees to be on mute when not speaking.
- 7. If a commissioner wishes to speak, they will raise their hand using the raise hand feature. The facilitator/Chair/Co-chair will call on Commissioners/attendees in the order of their hand raise.
- 8. The Charter Review commission has 15 Commissioners, please be mindful of how often and how long you are speaking to make sure everyone has an opportunity to speak on issues.
- 9. The Chair/Co-chair that is presiding over the meeting has the authority to suggest a reasonable time limit, remind a commissioner to allow input from everyone or call on a commissioner that has not been heard from.
- 10. These ground rules may be amended by the commission to accommodate changes in meeting structure, voting preferences or facilitation by a simple majority of the commissioners.
- 11. Public comments: are limited to 3 minutes, must be in reference to the work of the Charter Review Commission, and follow the guidelines of the general ground rules.
