Activities begin at 7 a.m. the station house at Fire District 6, 8800 NE Hazel Dell Ave., with the Lions Club annual breakfast (\$6.50 for adults, \$5.50 for seniors and kids). It runs until 10 a.m. There will be NO fun run/walk event. The Parade of Bands starts at 10:30 a.m. from the fire station.

The theme is "Follow Your Dreams," and it honors our own Miss Clark County – and Miss Washington – Alicia Cooper. We are fortunate she was able to work our parade into her busy schedule. Please come out and celebrate her successes and wish her well as she passes in the parade. It is a great family and community celebration!

The annual Parade of Bands is organized by the Hazel Dell/Salmon Creek Business Association, and is paid for by that organization and generous sponsoring businesses and individuals. Volunteers from several agencies donate their time to help make this event a memorable one each year.

Residents will have limited access across Hazel Dell Avenue and **no** access to the 78th Street off-ramps to I-5 after 10 a.m. The parade route is from 8800 Hazel Dell Ave. south to 63rd Street/Minnehaha Street, east across the freeway overpass to NE Highway 99, and north to 78th Street, where marchers will turn east and disband in the parking area (see map on next page). Clark Public Utilities will offer water there. Let me know if you need help in leaving your property during the parade -10:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. is the estimated impact period.

If you have an access issue, **let me know EARLY**, not on Parade Day, so I can talk to the CCSO deputy in charge to work out a safe route and time to cross the parade route.
