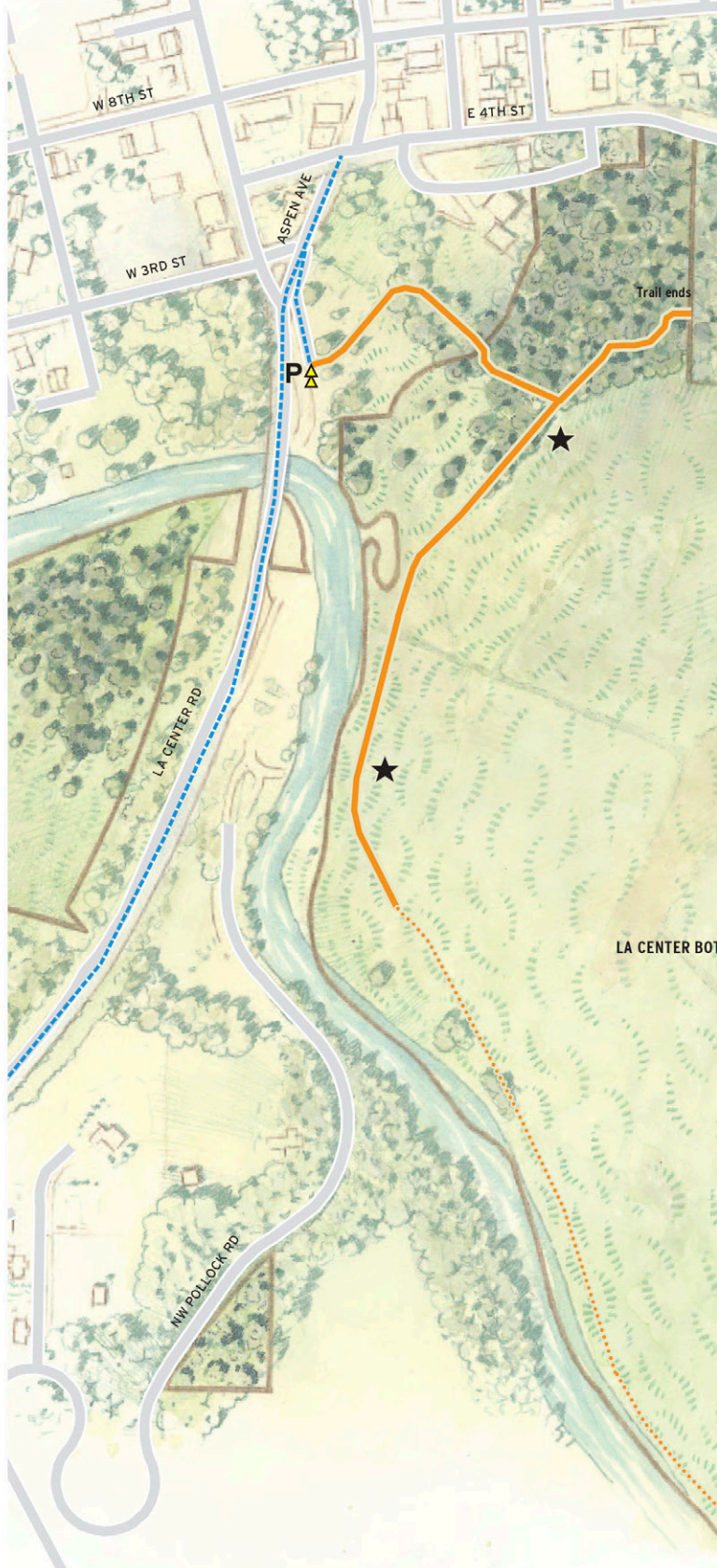


La Center Bottoms
