  - Exploring possible collaboration on next year's stormwater permit behavior change requirements
- Student Watershed Monitoring Network planning for culminating event in late May or early June at the Water Resources Education Center. Idea is to have participants share posters of their findings and invite teachers and families.
- New Interlocal Agreement with WSU Extension to fund deliverables completed through the Small Acreage Program – going to council on Feb. 20
- Ecology grant – listed as funded, still pending legislative funding approval. May include:

  - Changing Currents tribal engagement
  - What's Your Lawn Style fertilizer/pesticide reduction behavior change campaign
  - Latinx landscape professional fertilizer/pesticide reduction training

- Clean River Coalition:
  - National Center for Alternatives for Pesticides (NCAP) piloted a virtual training for Latino landscape professionals with 35 in attendance.
