Hello Jerry,

I confirmed today that the amount of low income repair funds we originally communicated to you had changed. Here are the amounts approved by our board, by category, that are available as of July 1, 2021 for the next fiscal year ending June 30, 2022:

1. Emergency Heat Repair \$35,000
2. Weatherization Related Repairs 35,000
3. Misc. Energy/Water Related Repairs \$25,000

We are thrilled that the amounts did not change from 2020/2021. Please let me know if there are any additional questions.
