SHERIFF’S UPDATE: In April of this year, Washington State Legislature passed police reform bills HB 1054 and 1310, which went into effect on 7/25/2021. These new regulations impact police response, tactics and procedures. You can find Sheriff Atkins’ statement in response at ccso@clark.wa.gov

COUNTY JAIL: The Clark County Jail completed construction in 1984. It was designed to hold 300 beds. In 2021 the same jail has been rearranged to currently hold an overcrowded 500+ inmates. This has a direct effect on arrest limitations for law enforcement and constant adjustment of court-ordered sentencing. We will keep you informed and let you know of any opportunities to support actions to address this situation.
