Legislative Update for Clark County DDAB

Since the last time we met in March, Governor Inslee has signed all legislation that passed during the 2024 Legislative Session. As a recap, some of the highlights are, SB 5882 – Burdan of Proof, HB 1916 – Funding for ESIT, HB 2116 – Increasing the SpEd Funding cap, and E3SHB 1541 – Establishing the "Nothing About Us Without Us" Act. As we look to the remainder of the year, we are on the cusp of campaign season. Now, this is the time to work diligently on our legislative priorities for 2025.
