- This property provides habitat for at least 89 types of mammals, birds and fish. Can you spot some wildlife?
- Coyote, raccoon, opossum, black-tailed deer, bat, chipmunk

- Crow, red-tailed hawk, kestrel, Cooper's hawk, greathorned owl
- American goldfinch, evening groesbeak, pine siskin, marsh wren
