Compensation shall be ((determined by the Board of County Commissioners)) based upon ((the engineer's report of the vacated county road.)) the appraised value of the vacated site based on the value of adjoining property, considering any applicable adjustment for limited market use. All appraisals shall be in accordance with applicable appraisal practices and in conformance with the Uniform Standard of Professional Appraisal Practice (USPAP). All appraisals shall undergo a review process with compensation determined by the reviewer.
