Working together to keep our watersheds healthy

- Never dump anything down a storm drain. Storm drains and ditches lead to streams.
- Use a commercial car wash or wash your car over grass with phosphorus-free, non-toxic soap.
- Fix vehicle leaks promptly.
- Reduce the need for fertilizers and pesticides by planting native plants.
- Avoid hazardous household products and always follow directions for use, storage, and disposal.
- Recycle paint, motor oil, and antifreeze.
- Compost or recycle yard debris.
- Pull weeds by hand instead of using chemicals.
- Pick up pet waste, bag it, and put in the garbage.
