### **Member and County Updates**

 But the County continues to operate at a structural deficit. The Veterans fund should not be impacted

### **Committee Reports**

Appeals: No appeals have been received

Policies and Procedures: A policy change for assisting Veterans with rent assistance during this pandemic was requested. The following wording will be submitted to the Clark County Council following a motion by Shannon Roberts that was seconded by Jim Jensen and passed unanimously:

During a state or federal declaration of emergency, limitations on rental assistance due to accommodations made by governmental bodies to restrict evictions will not interfere with providing rental assistance to those Veterans who otherwise are eligible. Veterans can be assisted with up to six months of rental arrears during an emergency declaration.

## May 2020 Contractor Reports & Fund Report

The fund assisted 22 Veteran households. The Veterans Assistance Center received 185 Veteran visits for essentials and food. The Free Clinic was not operating in May but was referring Veterans to needed dental care. The Fund balance at the end of May was \$788,897.

# Veterans Assistance Center (VAC) Update

- The Center is open daily 9am-Ipm, operating with three staff and one volunteer. Clients are not allowed in the building.
- Five Veterans received burial assistance in the past week.
- Rental assistance currently requires an eviction letter from Veteran's landlord.
- Stand Down date and location are to be determined. Supplies are being collected

#### **New Business**

#### Open Forum

- On March 6, the VA took ownership of the Fourth Plain cemetery, which has been renamed The Fort Vancouver National Historic Cemetery.
- The recruiting center is now on the upper level of the mall
