# 9-DAY CLOSURE

The northbound span of the Interstate Bridge closes **September 12–20, 2020** as crews replace mechanical parts that help lift and lower the bridge. The southbound span will remain open to traffic in both directions



### MORNING COMMUTE Two southbound lanes and one northbound lane.



### EVENING COMMUTE Two northbound lanes and one southbound lane.







# CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS: AUGUST-OCTOBER 2020

While the heaviest impacts to travelers will occur during the closure of the northbound span of the bridge in September, traffic impacts will occur throughout construction, including:

#### 7-DAY LANE CLOSURE ON I-5 SOUTH

Single lane closure on I-5 south at the Interstate Bridge **September 21–27, 2020**. Expect delays traveling into Oregon.

#### **NIGHTTIME LANE CLOSURES**

Beginning in August, periodic nighttime single and double lane closures will occur on I-5 and the Interstate Bridge throughout construction.

#### **BRIDGE LIFTS ON I-5 NORTH**

Bridge lifts will occur on I-5 north for up to 30 minutes. Travelers should expect delays.

#### **NIGHTTIME RAMP CLOSURES**

Periodic nighttime closure of on-ramps:

- SR 14/Washington Street on-ramp to I-5 south in Vancouver.
- Marine Drive on-ramp to I-5 north in Portland.
- Hayden Island on-ramp to I-5 north in Portland.
- North Victory on-ramp to I-5 north in Portland.

# AREA RAMP CLOSURES DETOUR MAPS

# SR 14/Washington Street On-Ramp to I-5 South Detour

#### From downtown Vancouver:

- Turn right onto Columbia Street.
- Turn right onto Mill Plain Boulevard.
- Turn right for the on-ramp to I-5 south.

#### From SR-14 west:

- Merge onto I-5 north.
- Take Exit 1D for 4th Plain Boulevard.
- Turn left onto E 4th Plain Boulevard.
- Turn right to merge onto I-5 south



# AREA RAMP CLOSURES DETOUR MAPS

### I-5 North Off-Ramp to SR 14 Detour

- Take Exit 1D for 4th Plain Boulevard.
- Turn left onto E 4th Plain Boulevard.
- Turn right to merge onto I-5 south.
- Take Exit 1A to SR 14 east.



# AREA RAMP CLOSURES DETOUR MAPS

### **Hayden Island On-Ramp to I-5 North Detour**


- Take I-5 south.
- Take Exit 306.
- Turn right onto N. Victory Boulevard.
- Turn left for the on-ramp to I-5 north.

### **Marine Drive On-Ramp to I-5 North Detour**

- Take Marine Dr. to I-5 south.
- Take Exit 306.
- Turn right onto N. Victory Boulevard.
- Turn left for the on-ramp to I-5 north.



# TRAFFIC IMPACTS DURING CONSTRUCTION

### **INCREASED BACKUPS**



The length of backups may double to 4 miles during the closure.

### **INCREASED DEMAND AND CONGESTION**



Increased demand and congestion on I-205 and connecting routes on I-84 and SR 14.



Currently: about 7 hours of congestion a day.

During the closure: expect up to 16 hours of congestion a day.







# TRAVEL STRATEGIES & OPTIONS

Everyone can help reduce congestion during the two-week closure by using options such as:



Delaying or shifting trips



Working from home or alternate location if possible




Bus and transit



Passenger rail service



Rideshare, vanpool and carpool\*










### TRANSIT IMPROVEMENTS: C-TRAN AND TRIMET

- Transit services will be enhanced with additional buses on existing routes.
- C-TRAN will operate busses on the shoulders of I-5, SR 14 and I-205 across the Glenn Jackson Bridge.
