#### I. Introductions

Councilor DesRochers was appointed to serve as chair until Councilor Olson's arrival.

#### II. August 10, 2020, Meeting Minutes

The minutes were approved following a motion made by David Scott and seconded by Councilor Moseley.

#### III. CARES Act CDBG-CV3 funding

Upon motion by Dave Scott that was seconded by Councilor Moseley, the board established the additional \$935,000 CDBG-CV funds will be awarded non-competitively on UCPB recommendation and County Council approval to get the funding distributed rapidly in the community. Activities funded must prevent, prepare for, or respond to COVID-19 and meet HUD CDBG criteria.

Councilor DesRochers made a motion to award \$379,000 to the Battle Ground Free Clinic for needed COVID-related repairs. The motion was seconded by Councilor Moseley and passed. Awards for the remaining funds will be discussed in November.

### IV. Program updates

Small business assistance of \$1.042M was awarded to 162 businesses throughout Clark County. Fourth Plain Forward has been contracted to provide an additional \$500,000 in assistance serving 75 businesses along the Fourth Plain corridor. Funds must be spent by the end of November. County Council and City of Vancouver have also provided small business assistance.

#### V. 2019 CAPER

From July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020, \$2.77M CDBG and HOME funds were expended towards 18 activities approved by the Urban County Policy Board.

## VI. Other

Community Needs Assessment forums are scheduled for October 27-29, 2020. Public participation is requested. The forums will discuss needs and priorities of households with lowincome in Clark County and describes poverty in our community.
