Key Features:

- Acquires one of the last waterfront parcels with nearly ½ mile of Columbia River Frontage in the vicinity of the Camas/Vancouver border
- Property abuts two parcels owned by the State Department of Transportation with an addition ¼ mile of Columbia River Frontage
- Provides an opportunity to increase public recreation access to the Columbia River. Could become a trailhead for the Lewis and Clark Trail.
- Supports a variety of county and regional plans, including County’s *Conservation Areas Acquisition Plan, County Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Plans, Regional Trails and Bikeway Systems Plan, Lower Columbia Fish Recovery Plan, Lewis and Clark Concept Trail Plan.*
