PIT Count-What is it?

- ► Single Night Snapshot
- Required by HUD & WA Dept. of Commerce
- Used to review trends
- New tools and increased effectiveness in counting each year
- Enables better planning and funding determinations
- ▶ Best available data



Data Sources

- Sheltered Count
 - ► Homeless Management Information System
 - ▶ Non-HMIS shelters
- Unsheltered Count
 - ▶ Non HMIS Service Locations
 - SafePark Program
 - ► School District Homeless Liaisons
 - ► Street Count
 - ► Project Homeless Connect Event



2021 PIT Count & COVID

- COVID effected the Jan 28, 2021 count in multiple ways
- Sheltered Count Only
- Reduced bed capacity in shelters due to social distancing restrictions
- People avoiding congregate shelters out of concern



Overview of 2021 Sheltered PIT Count results. # of People by shelter type.

	Emergency	Transitional	Combined
Jan 30, 2020	268	132	400
Jan 28, 2021	213	162	375
% change	-20.5%	+22.73%	-6.25%
