<p>Communications / Announcements / Citizen Comments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dan met with Jim Malinowski and two others from the north end of the line.</li> <li>• Dan and John Shaffer attended a meeting with the Brush Prairie sub-group. They also attended Greater Brush Prairie Neighborhood Association (GBPNA) meeting. Rick, Dan, and Councilor Medvigy spoke to the group. The response was positive and there was good feedback. There continues to be progress with on-going communication.</li> <li>• Councilor Medvigy has mentioned applying 5517 for entire length of the line. John Shaffer wondered how the SEPA process would work. The Lagler property has already been through the environmental process.</li> <li>• Dan is participating on the Transportation System Plan Sounding Board. It is a level below an advisory board. There will be a meeting coming up on rail use and traffic patterns that Dan will be able to contribute to.</li> <li>• Jim Malinowski asked about shovel ready projects. There is talk of federal funds being available and the County and PVJR should be ready with projects. Tom responded that County projects would be in the railroad right of way. Might be applying for a CRISI grant again this year. Would use state appropriation as match.</li> <li>• John Shaffer said there were questions from the GBPNA about the capacity of Bridge 12 for larger trains. <p>repairs depends on the number and types of trains. There is a lot of work that needs to be done for before hauling unit trains with rock from Chelatchie. John stated that the bridges are the County's responsibility and the track is PVJR's.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dan spoke with Eric. The renderings are the targeted look. The 503 overpass is a dream for the future and very expensive.</li> <li>• Dan said that an in-person RRAB meeting is not likely for July based on his discussions with the County Manager.</li> </ul>
