<ul> <li>Communications / Announcements / Citizen Comments</li> <li>County management met with Eric Temple (PVJR) – It was confidential so no disclosure, but they are planning to meet again.</li> <li>Dan has had communication with PR firm hired by PVJR. There are eight letters in support of railroad development including Visit Vancouver, Granite Corporation, CREDC, Port of Vancouver, Omega Industries, and Pacific Mountain Silica. There are apparently 40 to 60 grass roots letters of support from Clark County Citizens United that are presumably in support of railroad development.</li> <li>Dan has a letter from Betty Sue Morris, former Clark County Commissioner. She states that she, Marc Boldt and Steve Stuart signed the letter starting the relationship with PVJR.</li> <li>Received approval for grant money from the state. The request for flexibility in how the previously appropriated money is spent was approved, but no additional funding was provided.</li> <li>Dan and John are going to meet again with some of the people from the Brush Prairie.</li> <li>Dan wants to meet with people from the north end of the line to hear about their wants, needs and desires.</li> </ul>	Dan Weaver, Chair

<ul> <li>Working on maintenance every weekend. Doug and Randy were replacing ties last Saturday.</li> <li>Have cleared track up to about MP 30. Beyond that it is very thick with downed trees. Maybe able to work with the owner of property adjacent to the tracks who will be logging.</li> <li>PVJR and County did weed spraying last week.</li> <li>Targeting to run for Father's Day weekend, but there is still a lot of work to do.</li> </ul>	Randy Williams, President
<ul> <li>County Activities</li> <li>Grants</li> <li>\$1.5 million for track rehab from MP 0 to 14.4 will be the first project.</li> <li>\$2.7 million for bridge repair and track rehab. Plan to repair Bridges 6, 12, 18 and 20. The remainder of the money will be used for ditching, undercutting, ballast, and ties on the north line. Inspection reports from HDR indicate that the bridges can be repaired and be serviceable. Bridge 12 has a few cars a week crossing to go out to Anderson Dairy in Battle Ground.</li> </ul>	Tom Grange, Clark County
