Goal 1: Partnerships

Old: Forge and maintain strong public, private and non-profit partnerships to support the parks and recreation system.

New: Forge and maintain strong partnerships

Goal 2: Communications & Promotion

Old: Promote and market the County's parks system.

Goal 3: Developed Parks

Old: Provide a diversified system of parks, trails, and open spaces that delivers a variety of recreational experiences to provide a high quality of life for residents.

New: Provide diverse recreational experiences

Goal 4: Trails

Old: Promote active lifestyles by providing more trail connections and coordinating with other jurisdictions and providers to create a seamless system.



New: Create a seamless trail system

Goal 5: Natural Areas

Old: Conserve significant natural areas to meet habitat protection needs and to provide opportunities for residents to recreate and connect with nature, as appropriate.

New: Conserve significant Natural Areas

Goal 6: Heritage

Old: Reflect the County's identity and preserve local heritage by incorporating art, history, and culture into the park system.



New: Preserve Clark County's heritage

Goal 7: Equity & Access

Old: Support and advance diversity, equity, inclusion in, and access to the County's system of parks, trails, and natural areas.

New: Advance diversity, equity, inclusion and access to parks

Goal 8: Operations

Old: Maintain and operate a modern, efficient park system that provides a high level of user comfort, safety, and aesthetic quality, and protects capital investments.



New: Maintain to improve experience & protect assets

Goal I: Partnerships

 Increase partnerships with local and regional recreation groups to help build and maintain trails and other assets.

Goal 2: Communication

- Improve County Website for recreational information
- Pilot QR codes or similar system to improve community access to information about parks

Goal 3: Developed Parks

- Master plan & develop Camp Bonneville
- Master plan & develop Brush Prairie Park
- Develop a Nature playground
