	QUESTION	ANSWER
1.	<p>Page 4 of the RFQ under 3. Scope of Project, Item 1 states <i>"Presently the county has approximately 90 locations with an approximate of 30% of these locations mapped onto the OPSInSight software."</i> What does a location consist of? Is there an attribute list or number of features list?</p>	<p>A location is typically at a signal/intersection/building where the fiber is brought up to a fiber splicing enclosure for patching and/or termination.</p> <p>The attribute list will consist of, but not limited to, cables, ductbank, enclosure, FDU's, and slacks. You can add/append them to the locations in the OSPInSight software as you add/append the various locations over there.</p>
2.	<p>Page 5 of the RFQ under 3. Scope of Project, Item 3 states <i>"Audit and update existing fiber optic routes..."</i> Will this only consist of a desktop audit?</p>	<p>Yes, you are correct, the consultant will be a responsible for desktop audit only. Some of the details can be found under Task 3 of Part II Section. IIC, Item 6.</p>
3.	<p>Page 13 of the RFQ under 2. Evaluation Criteria Scoring states <i>"A one hundred (100) point system will be used, weighted against the following criteria..."</i> and breaks down the various categories of scoring. We do not see pricing listed. Will Proposed Cost be taken in to consideration for this proposal? If so, how will that be weighted?</p>	<p>We will not be evaluating the consultant based on the cost estimate. Once we have selected the most competent consultant for the work, we will negotiate cost during the contract negotiation meeting. You are welcome to provide them in your proposal submission, but they will not be part of the scoring.</p>
