Question #1: Item 47 - Crack Sealing FA. Does this item include Traffic Control, Crack Seal Materials and Labor?
Reference: Inquiry did not identify
Answer: Section 1-09.6 paragraph 4 a lump sum bid item (bid items 3 and 4) required by a force account item will be paid by force account. Items with unit price bids required by a bid force account item (bid items 5, 6, 7, 8) will be paid at the bid unit price. Crack seal materials, labor and equipment are paid as force account reference section 1-09.

Question #2: There are no transverse or edge paving limits marked on the intersection of 76th Street and 117th. What are the limits here for paving? Is there paving in this intersection?
Reference: Inquiry did not identify
Answer: The limits of work are the County right of way. There is no work inside the WSDOT right of way. The WSDOT right of way is marked in the field. There is no paving in the intersection in this contract.

Question #3: Per specification section 5-04.3(3)D, placement of HMA on the existing surface ahead of the MTV is not allowed. Belly dumps are an industry-standard and accepted method of hauling HMA. Is it the County's intention to not allow belly dump style haul trucks on this project?
Reference: 5-04.3(3)D

Answer: The placement of HMA on the existing surface for pick up by a MTV, such as a windrow elevator, will not be allowed. Page 55 lines 28 and 29 of the special provisions. Belly dumps are allowed but the method of delivering the HMA to the MTV via windrow and elevator is not.
