Primary Policy and Goals

Policy:

Meet Phase I Municipal Stormwater Permit requirements

Goals:

- Protect and enhance streams and wetlands
- Minimize stormwater impacts to receiving waters
- Maximize public benefits of countyowned lands

Regulatory Requirements

Phase 1 Municipal Stormwater Permit:

- S5.C7 Structural stormwater controls prevent or reduce impacts to waters of state
 - New in 2019 permit Point system!
 - Maintenance and Operations

Underground Injection Control Program:

 County must address any drywells that pose a threat to groundwater

Growth Management Act:

Capital Facilities Plan includes stormwater

- Property Acquisition for Stormwater Benefit


