#### **Replacement Educational Programs and Operations Levy**

The Board of Directors of Evergreen School District No. 114 adopted Resolution No. 6604 concerning renewal of an expiring levy for educational programs and operations. This proposition provides funding for educational programs and operations expenses not funded by the State. If approved, Proposition 6 will authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, on all taxable property within the District, as provided in Resolution No. 6604.

#### Ridgefield School District No. 122 Proposition No. 8

#### General Obligation Bonds - \$62,565,000

The Board of Directors of Ridgefield School District No. 122 approved Resolution No. 2021-2022-006 concerning this proposition for bonds. This proposition would authorize the District to construct and equip a new elementary school and 8-plex classroom building at the new school site, and a new vocational and general education building at Ridgefield High School, by issuing \$62,565,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 21 years; and to levy excess property taxes annually to repay the bonds, as described in Resolution No. 2021-2022-006.
