



## Finance Reports: Funding Expended by Fund Source


Distribution of funding by fund source. Includes regular funds (dark teal) and COVID funds (orange) expended July 2021-June 2022.

## Finance Reports: Funding Expended by Service Type


Distribution of funding by type of service provided. Compares regular and COVID funds expended July 2021-June 2022.





## Finance Reports: Revenue Fund Sources


Comparison of fund sources received between state, local and federal awards. Includes regular and COVID related funds. Allocation timelines vary.
