 - a. WSDOT- CCPH and ECY met with WSDOT staff 12/07/2022. A draft Ops Plan has been submitted. CCPH is awaiting ECY review comments and feedback from ECY Clean Water Program prior to responding to WSDOT and proceeding with application process.
 - b. Circle C Pit (*NOTE: totally separate from Circle C Landfill*). John VanVessem submitted and incomplete NOI application. CCPH has requested ECY formally deny the request until a completed application has been submitted and routed for multiagency review/comment.
 - c. 3 Kings Environmental- ECY & CCPH learned of a location in Clark County processing of material (specifically, concrete and asphalt) on 10th AV. CCPH & ECY conducting a joint inspection 1/26/2023—more information to follow. (*NOTE: NOI will likely be required.*)
