

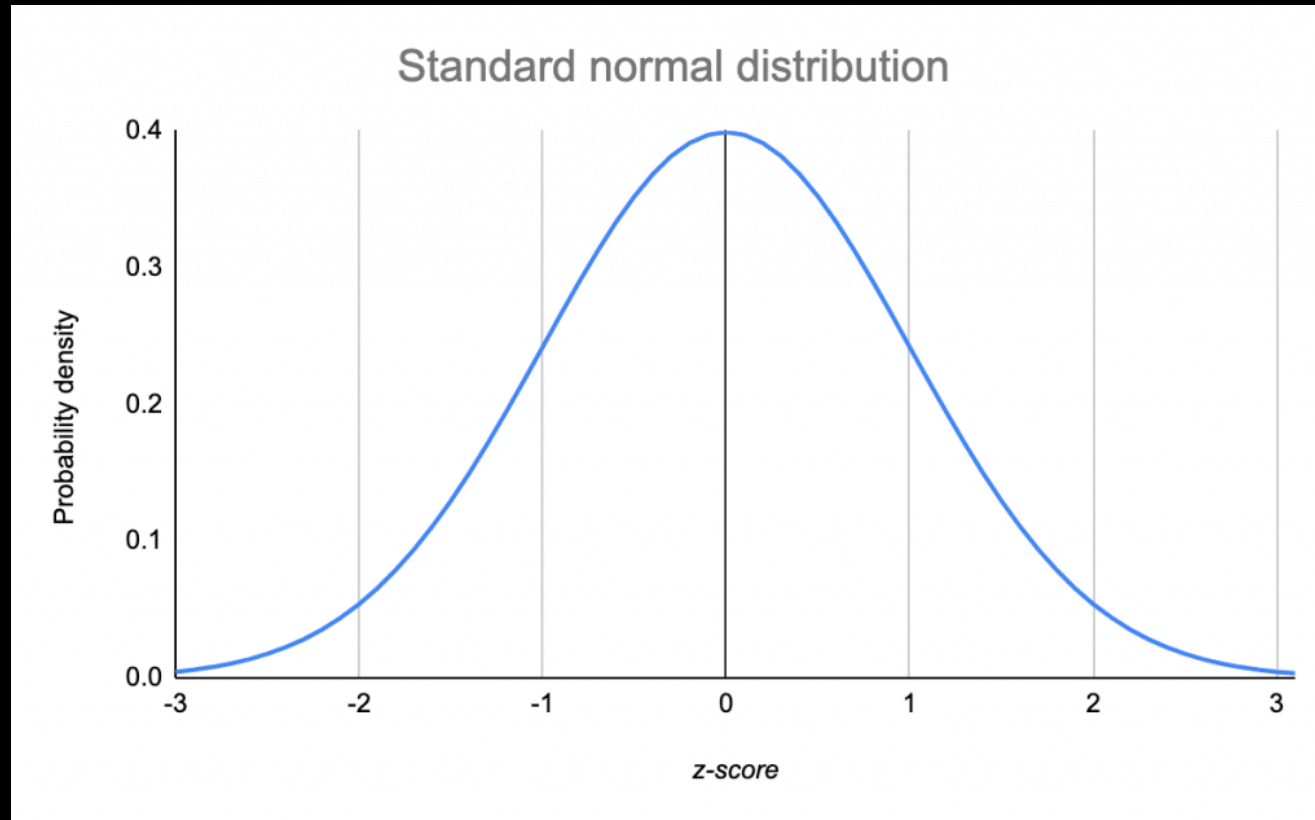

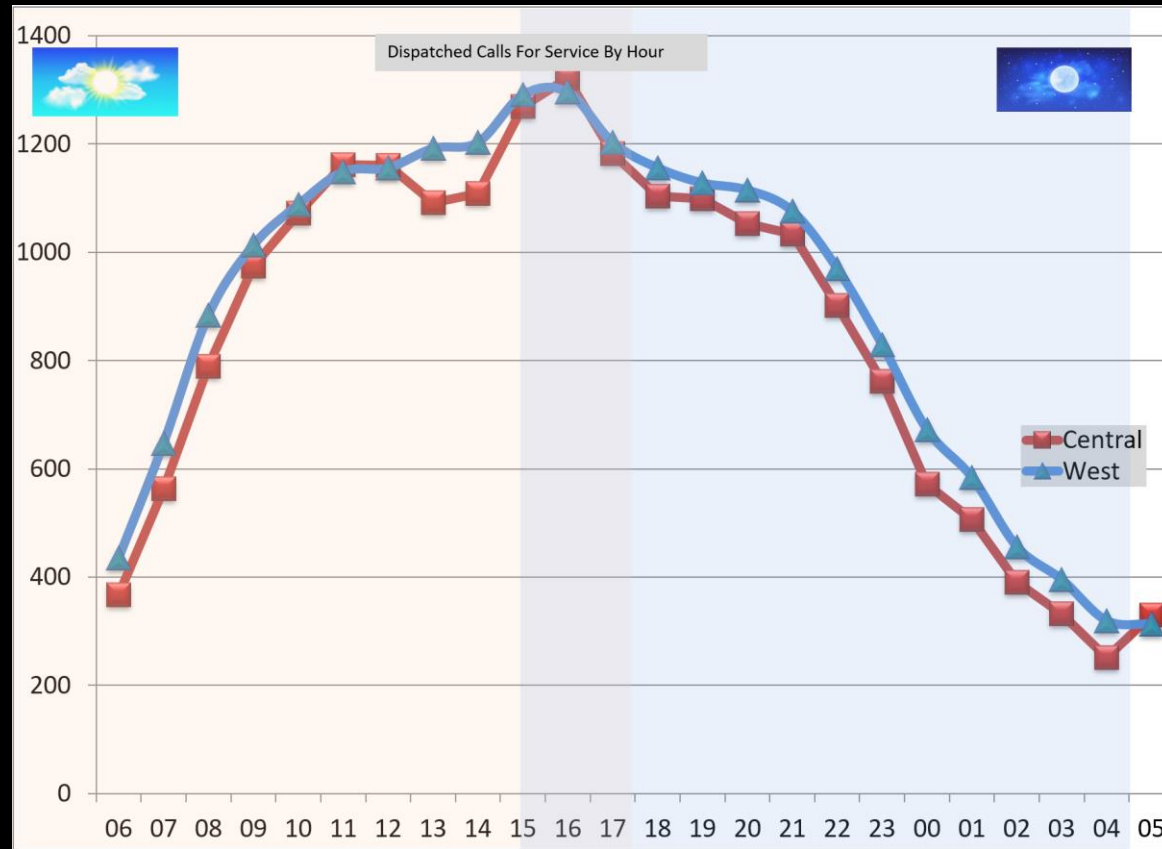

Fraud 2020 – by week.

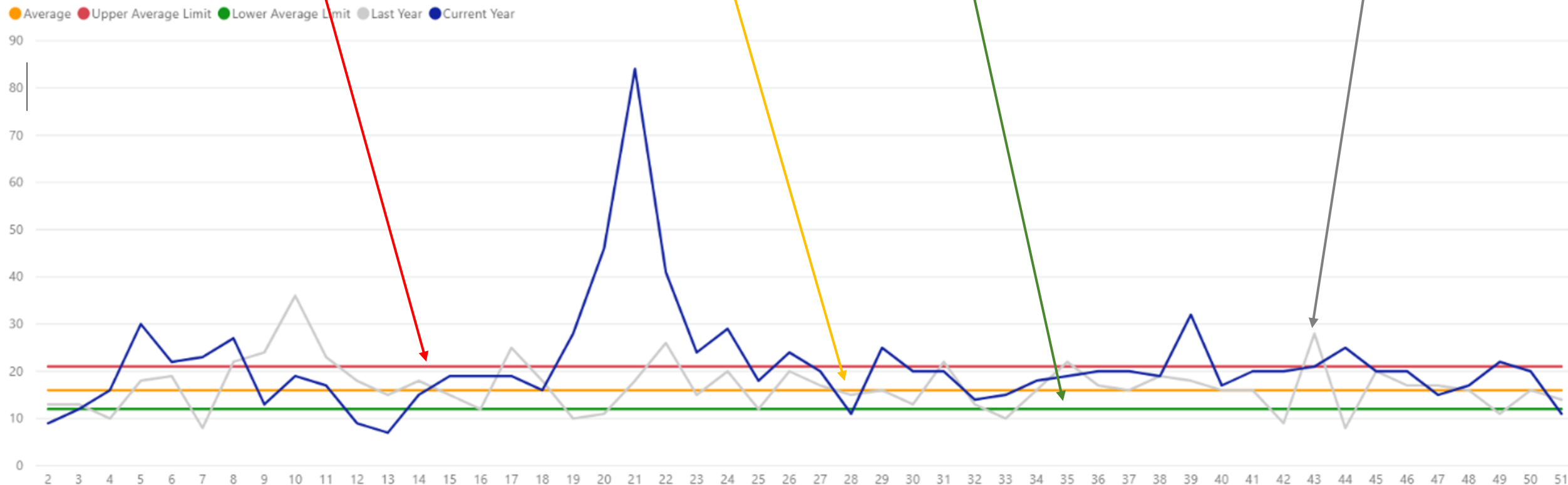
What is “not normal” ?

On any given week the **green line** shows the normal **minimum** number of fraud calls.

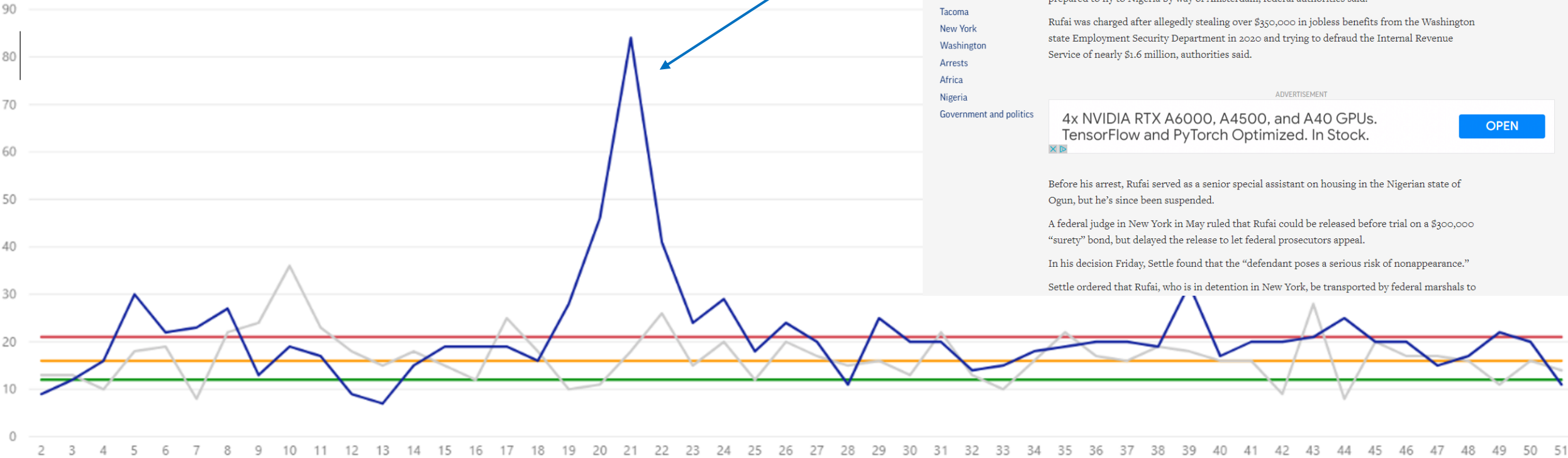
On any given week the **gray line** shows 2019 fraud calls.

SEATTLE (AP) — A Nigerian government official arrested in connection with Washington state’s \$650 million unemployment fraud will remain in jail until his trial, a federal judge ruled Friday.

U.S. District Judge Benjamin Settle of Tacoma agreed with federal prosecutors that Abidemi Rufai, 42, represented a flight risk and reversed an previous order granting him pretrial release, The Seattle Times reported.

Rufai, of Lekki, Nigeria, was arrested May 14 at New York’s John F. Kennedy Airport as he prepared to fly to Nigeria by way of Amsterdam, federal authorities said.

Rufai was charged after allegedly stealing over \$350,000 in jobless benefits from the Washington state Employment Security Department in 2020 and trying to defraud the Internal Revenue Service of nearly \$1.6 million, authorities said.

Before his arrest, Rufai served as a senior special assistant on housing in the Nigerian state of Ogun, but he’s since been suspended.

A federal judge in New York in May ruled that Rufai could be released before trial on a \$300,000 “surety” bond, but delayed the release to let federal prosecutors appeal.

In his decision Friday, Settle found that the “defendant poses a serious risk of nonappearance.”

Settle ordered that Rufai, who is in detention in New York, be transported by federal marshals to

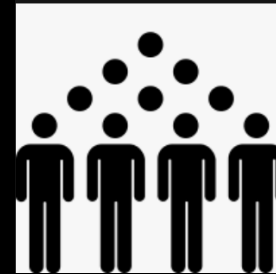

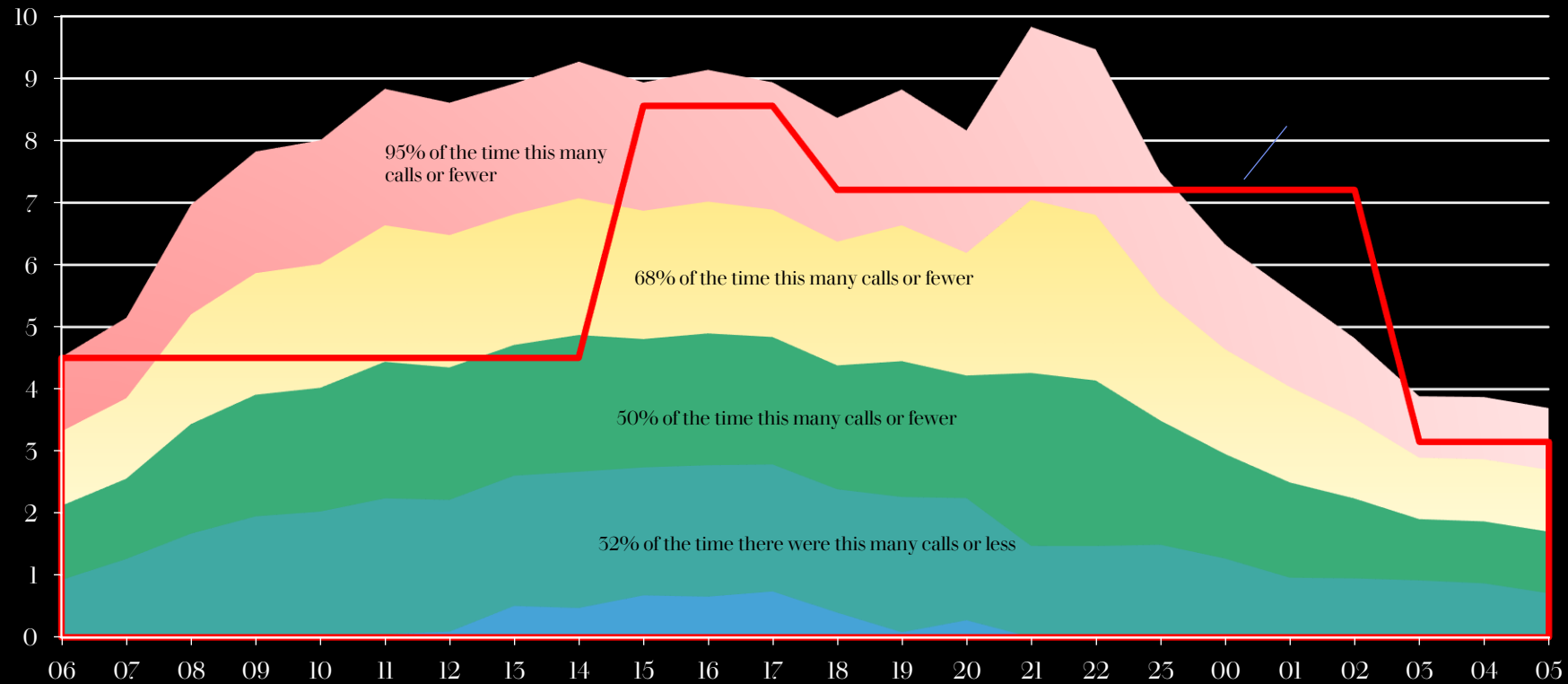
In 2018 – 27% of calls were patrol initiated.

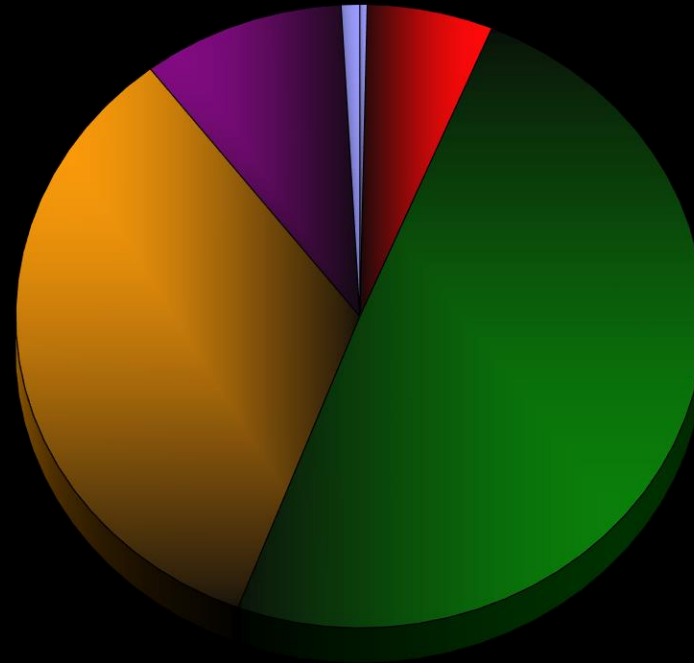

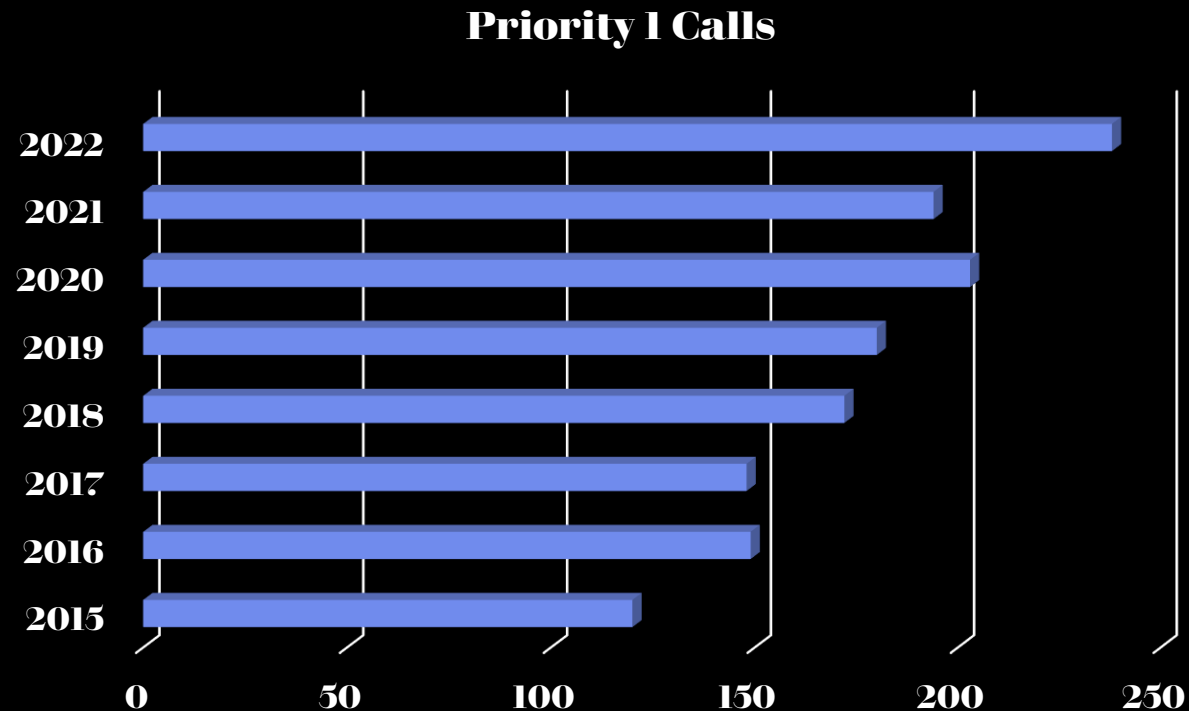
- Priority 1 – Someone is hitting you with a bat

- Priority 5 - Fireworks

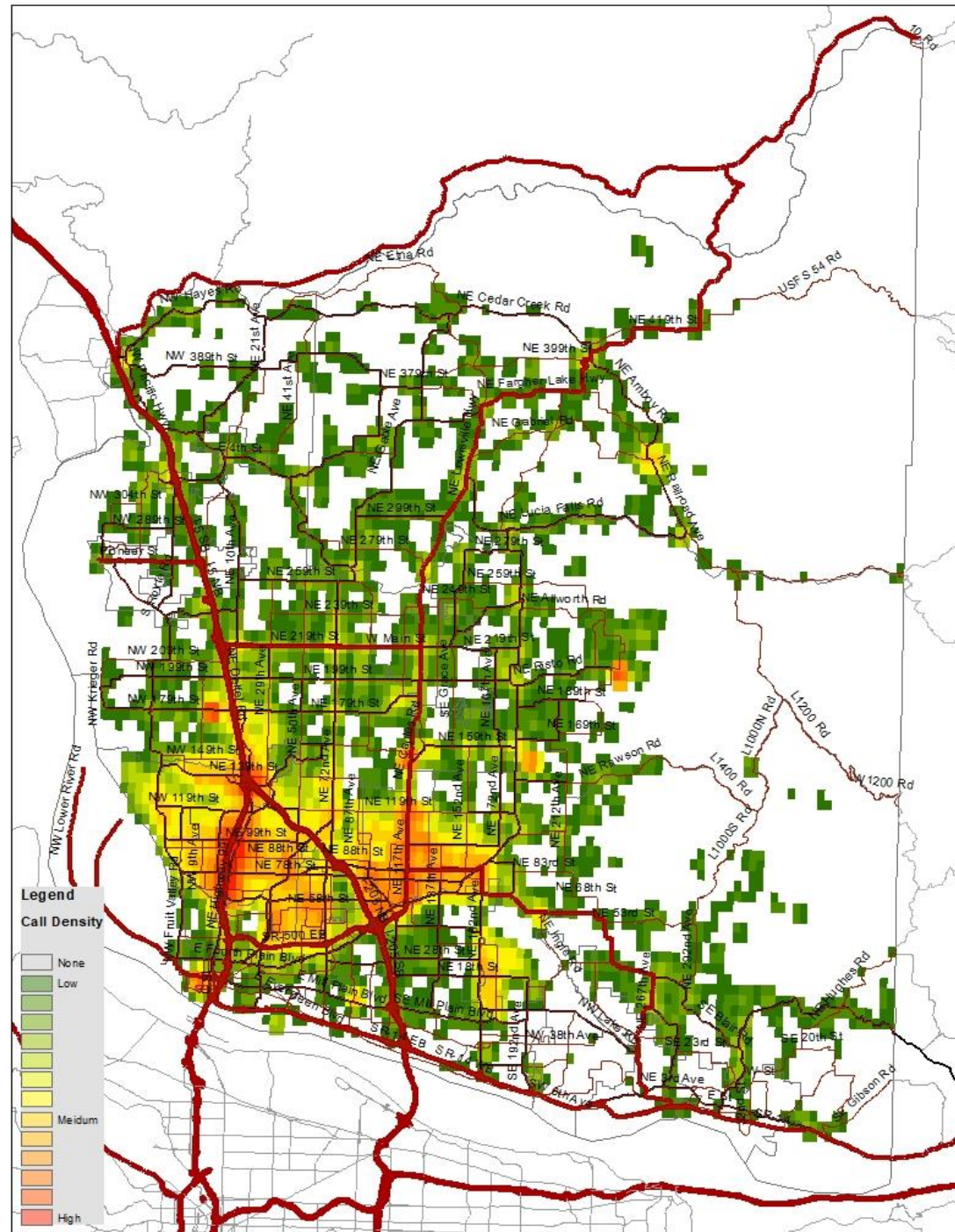

Priority 1 – Someone is hitting you with a bat

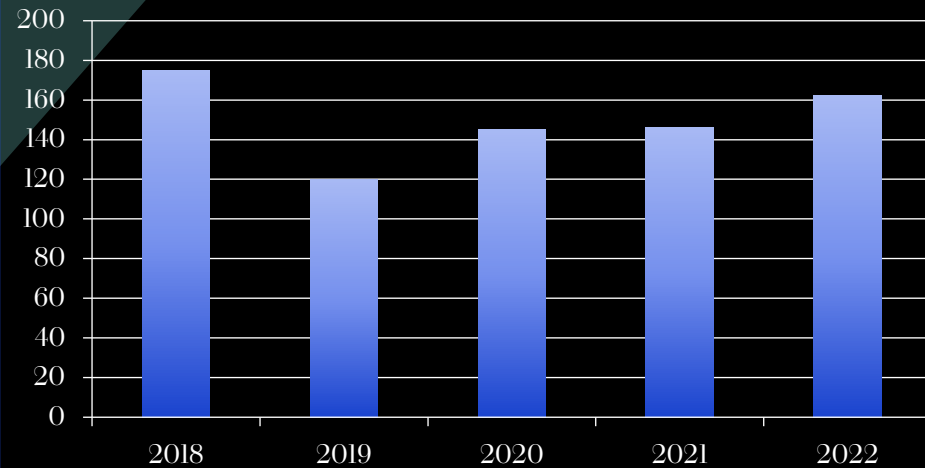
Most resource intensive of calls. CCSO (fully staffed) can only respond to two (2) priority 1 calls at one time.



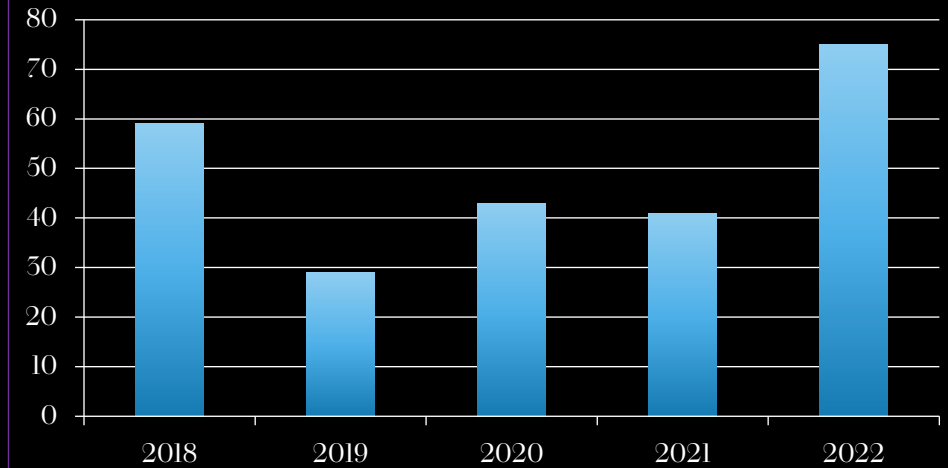

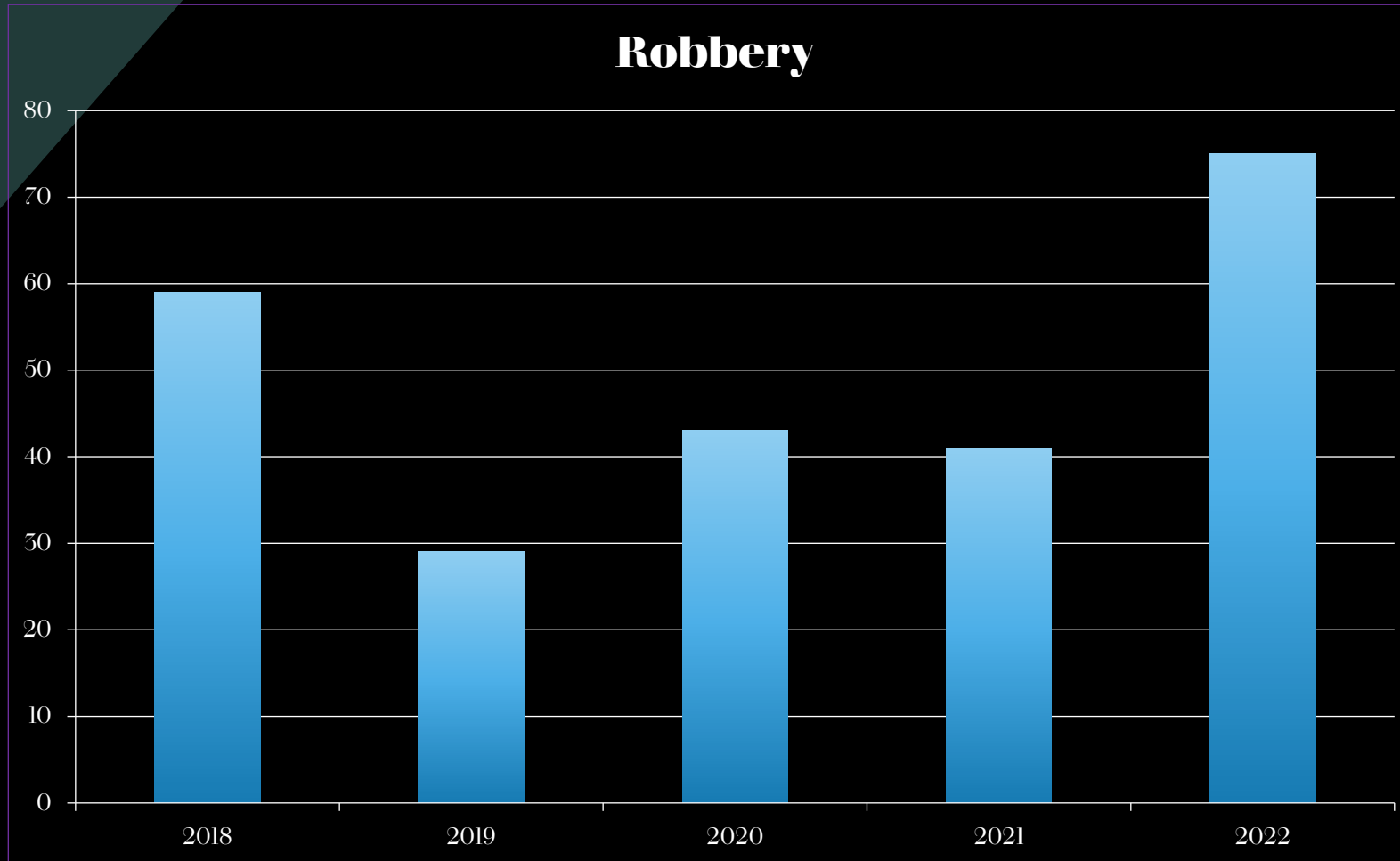


What is “a normal law enforcement activity” ?



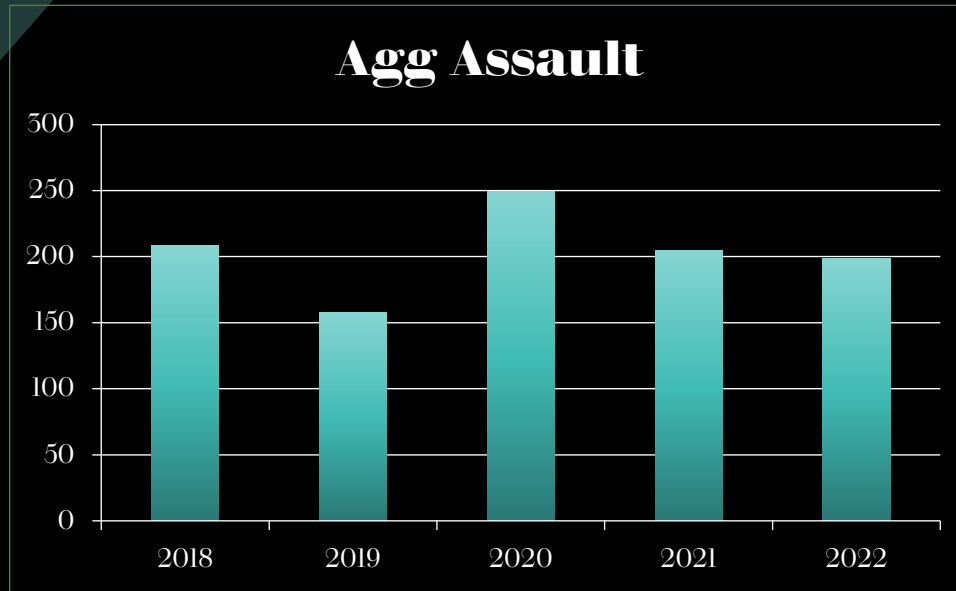
- In 2018 there was a large increase which coincides with the “Me Too Movement”
 - In 99.9% of the reported rape cases in Clark County, the victim knew the offender.
 - 50% to 70% of Rape cases involved alcohol or drugs by either the victim or the suspect.
- *The presence of alcohol or drugs does not excuse or justify sexual assault.

What is “a normal law enforcement activity” ?

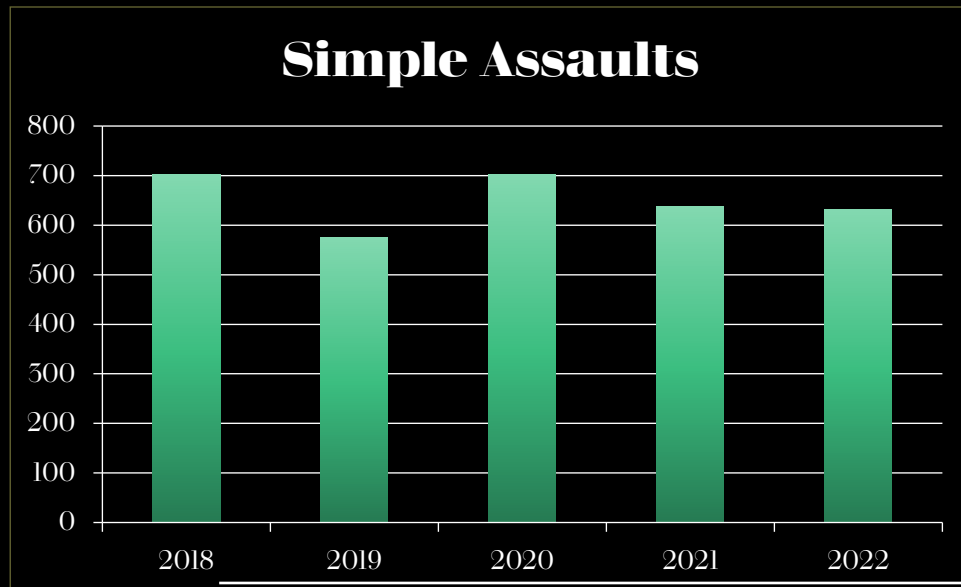


- The pandemic saw a sudden decrease in robbery.
- In 2022 the most common type of “Robbery” has been when a shoplifter pushes or threatens a store loss prevention officer.
- Bank Robberies have decreased over the past decade.

Tensions during the pandemic likely lead to the increase in Aggravated assaults.



Simple Assaults have been relatively constant from year to year.

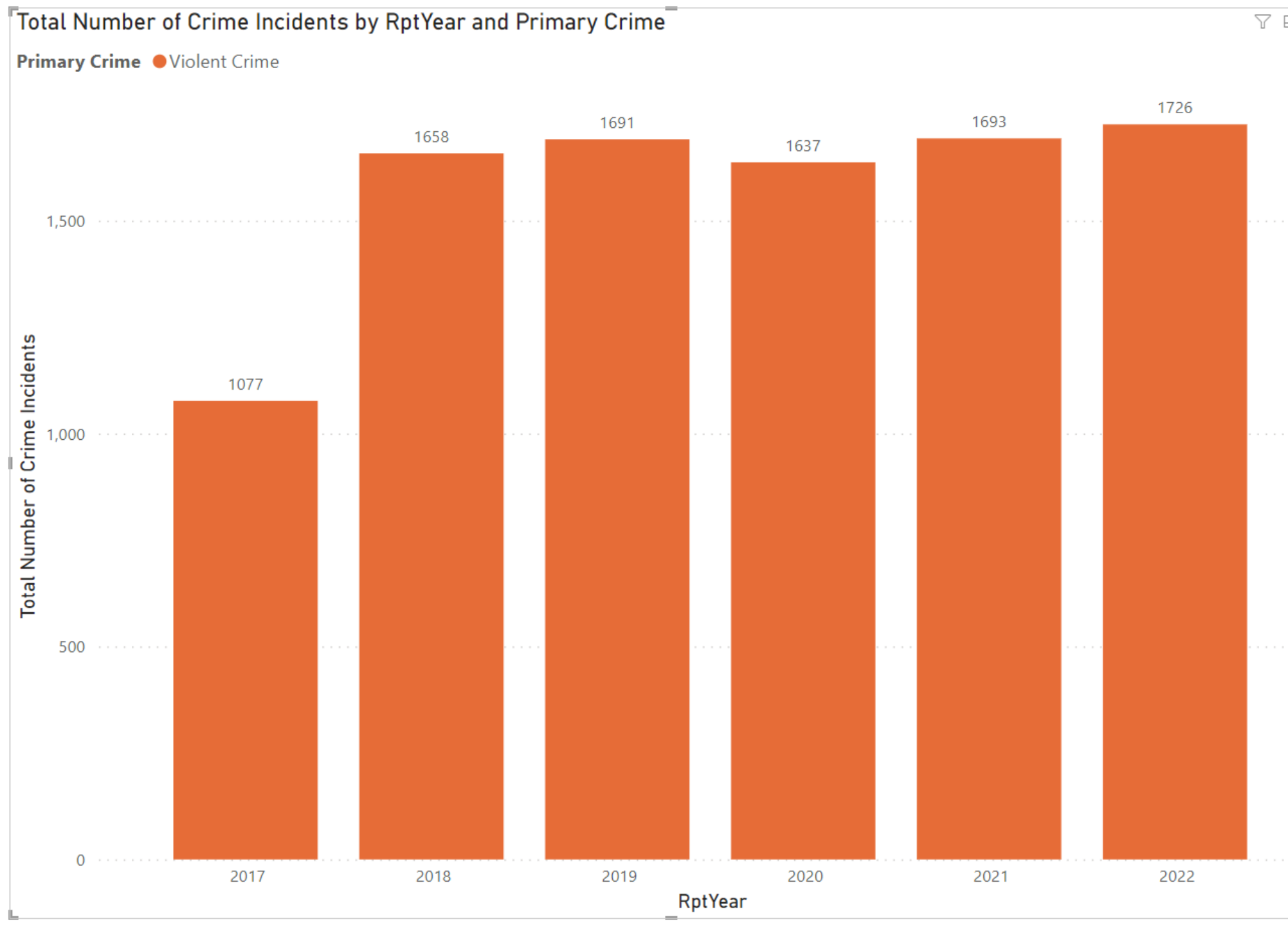
Violent Youth Crime

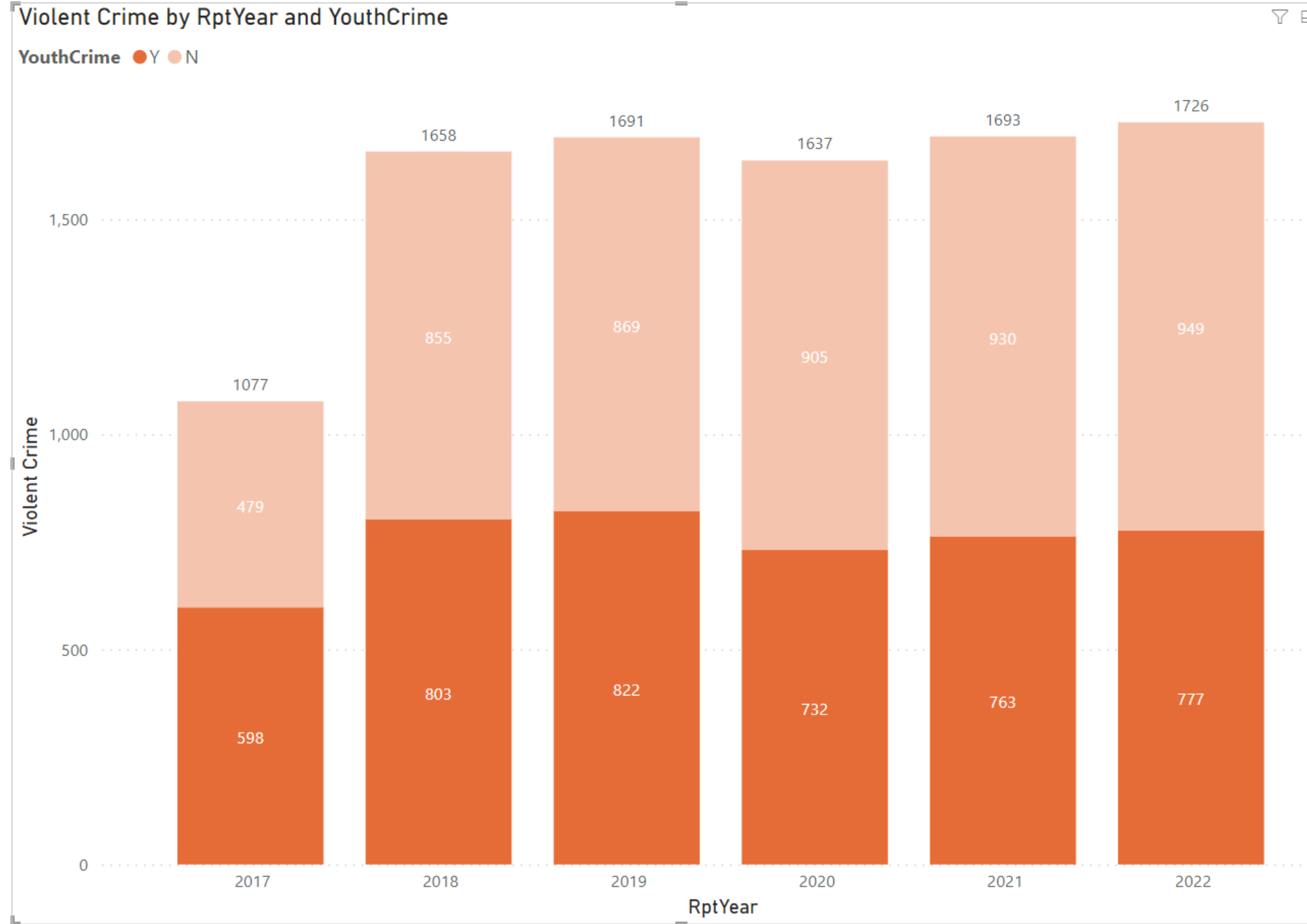

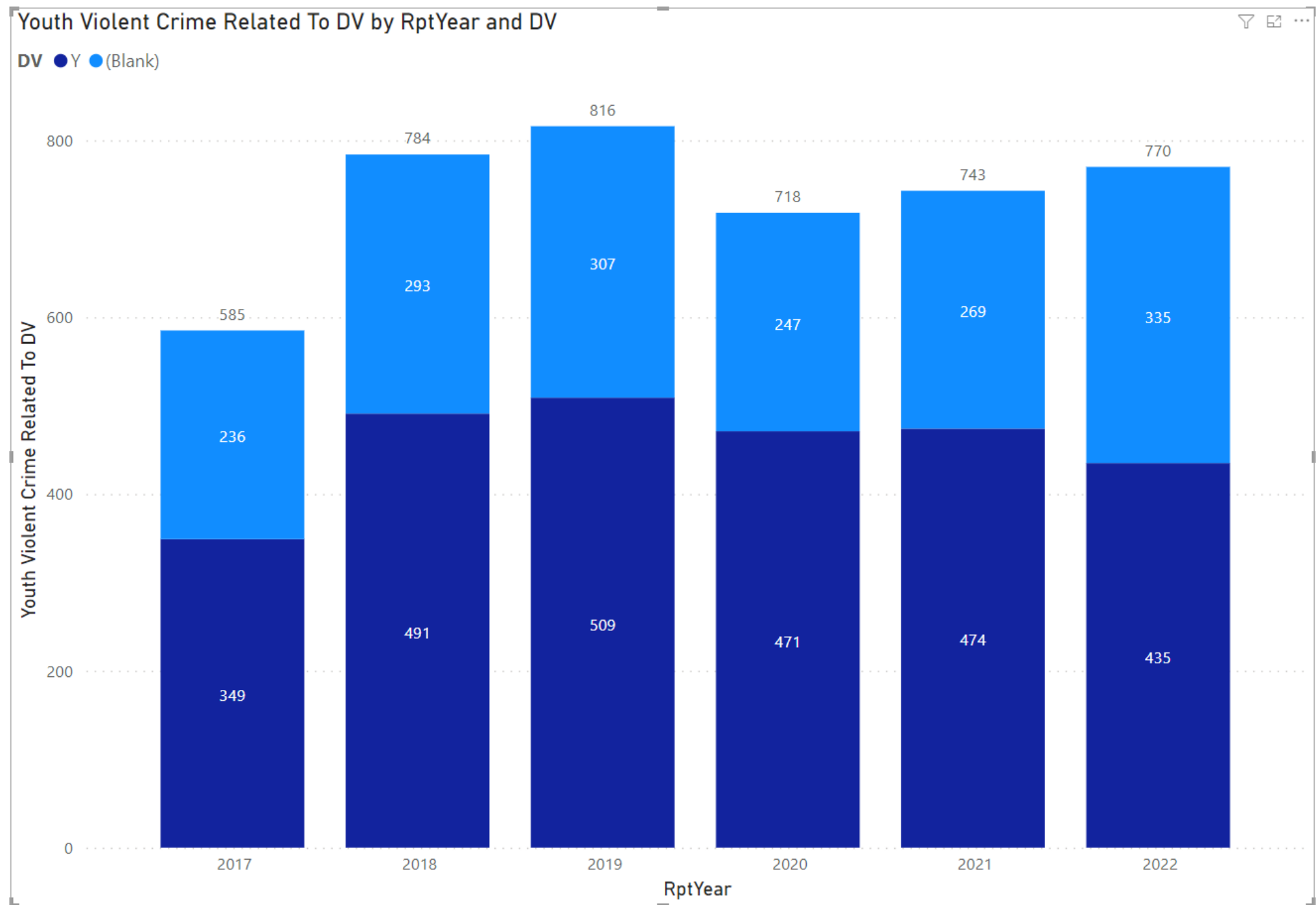
The Lighter Orange

More than half of youth violent crime is DV related.

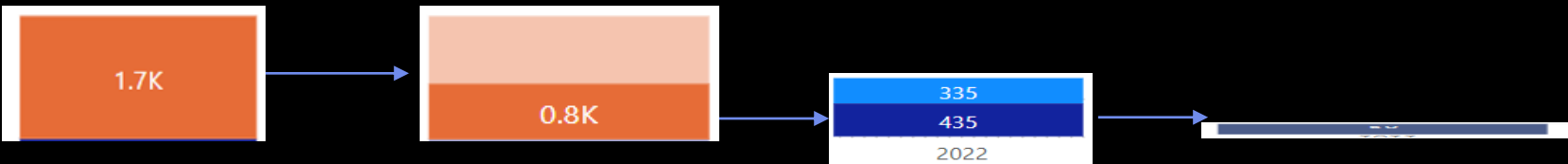




Let's drill further into the non-DV youth violence incidents. The data set is very small in comparison to the total volume of crime but is of central importance to saving young lives and helping improve public safety.

We will now focus on a set of very specific crimes:

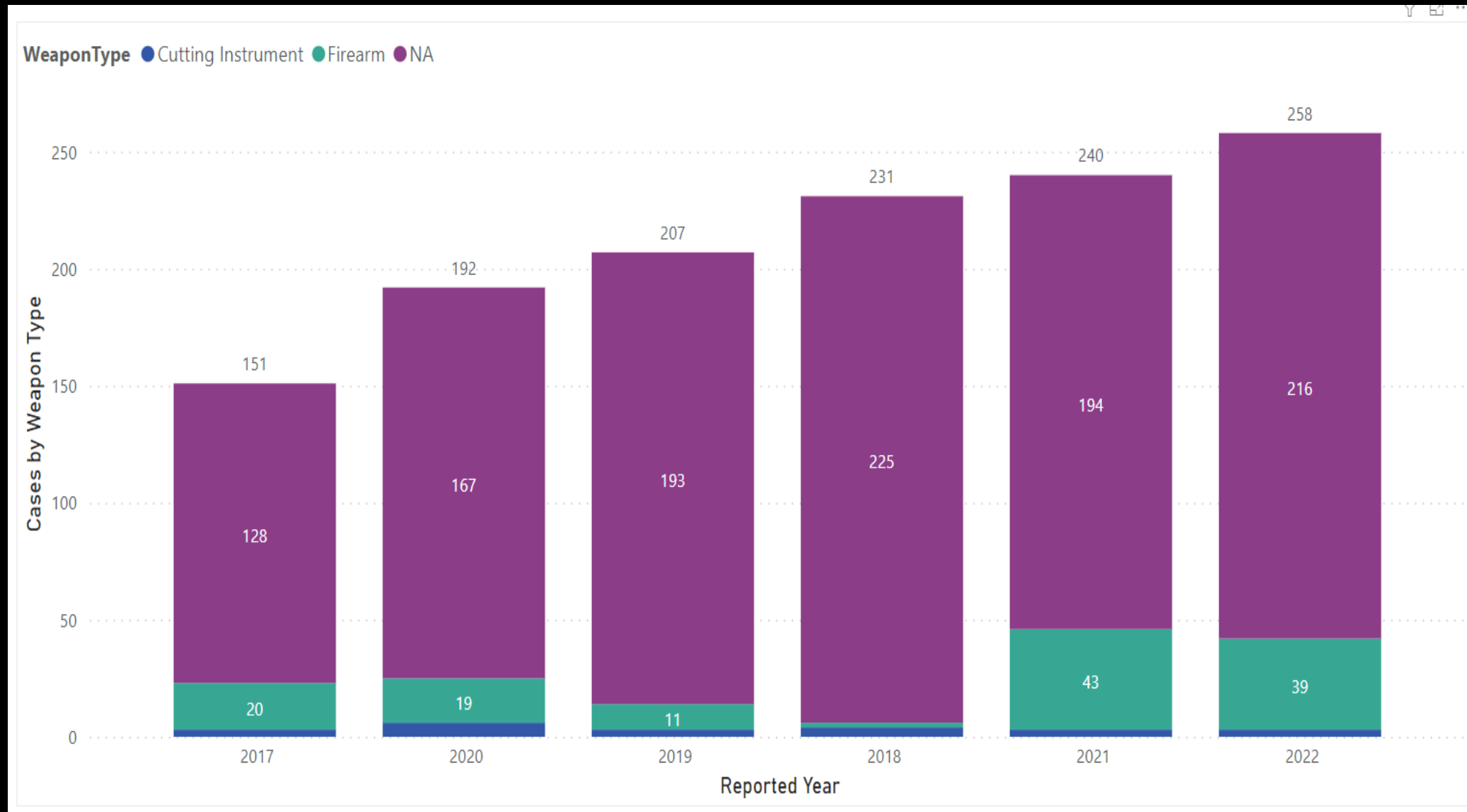
- Homicide

- Robbery

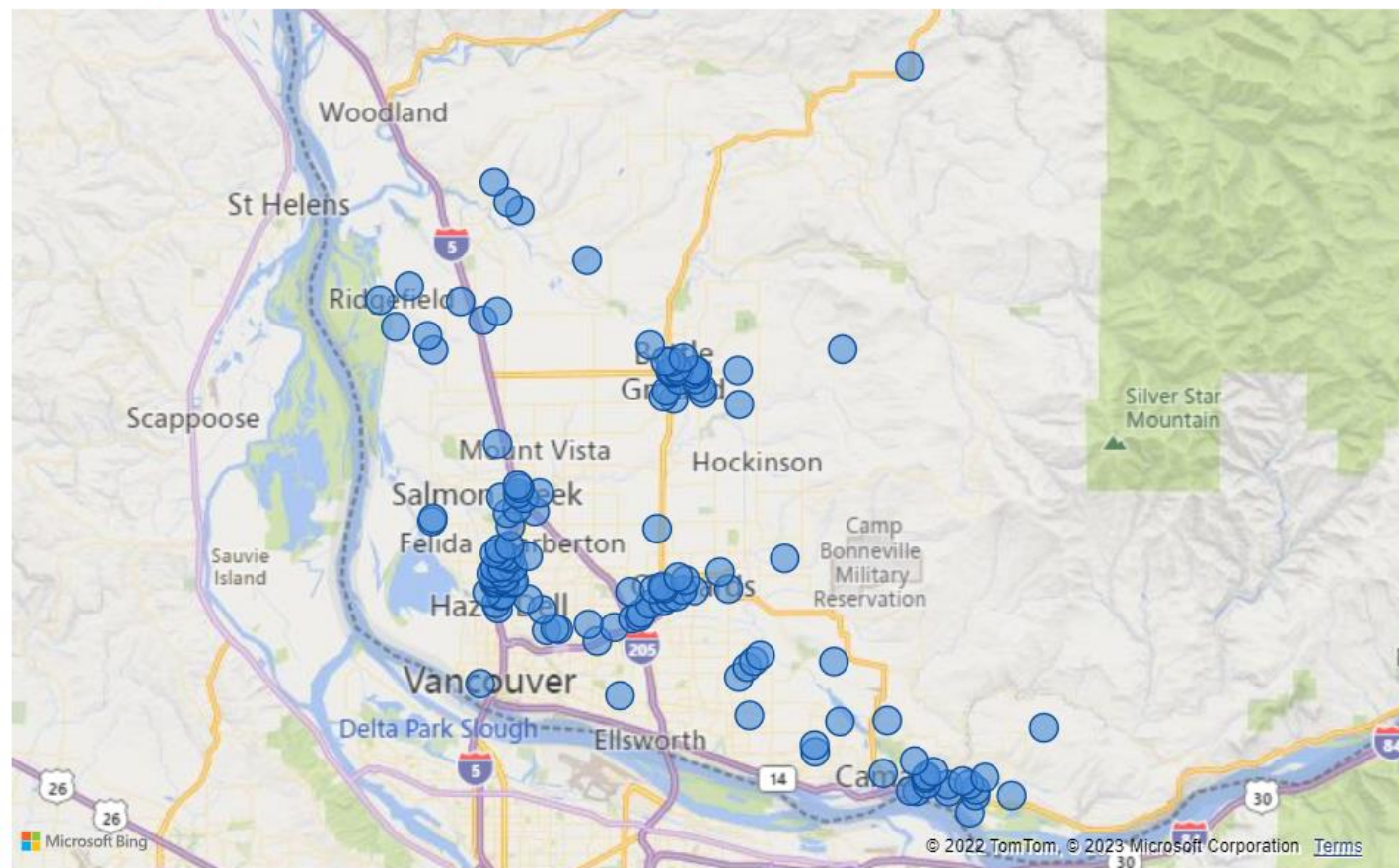


There has been an increase in non-dv youth Assaults, Homicides, and Robberies.

There has also been an increase in the use of firearms during these incidents

NA cases usually mean the suspect was unarmed. Hands / Feet / Fists were used in the assault or robbery.



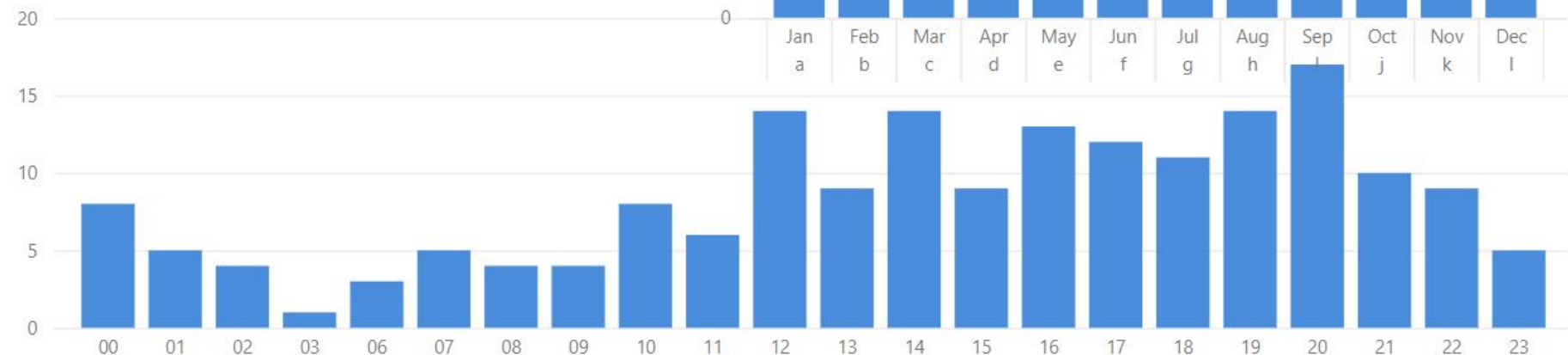
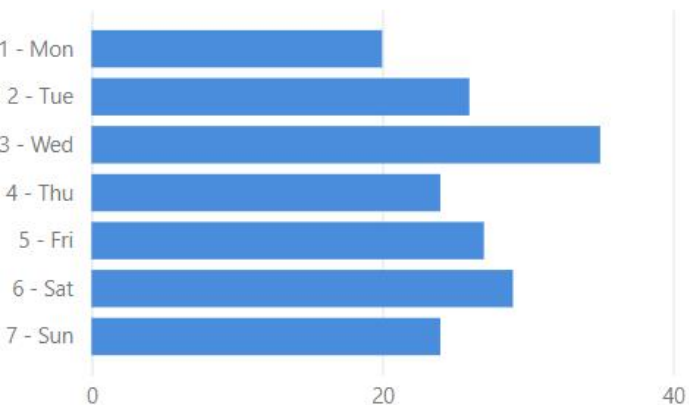


Youth Non-DV violent Crime very much trends with populated areas.

The most popular day of the week for non-DV youth violent incidents to occur is Wednesday.

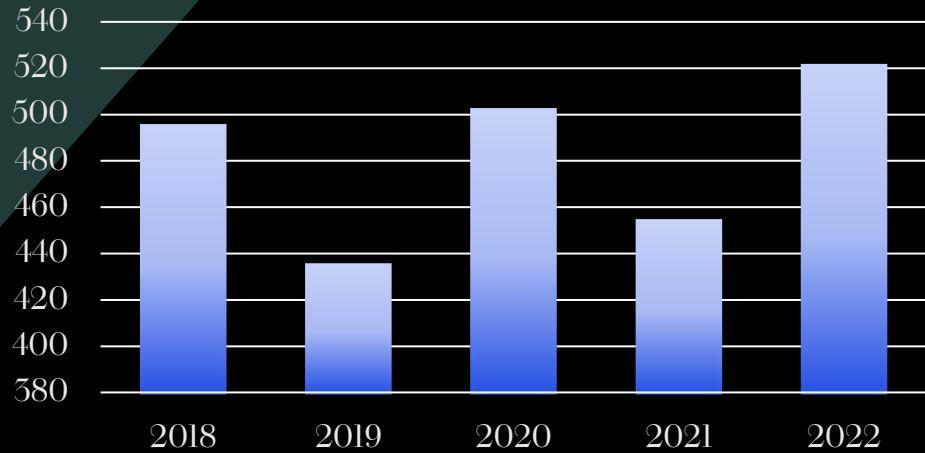
The most popular time is 8PM

The most common months non-DV violent crime occurs is September and January.

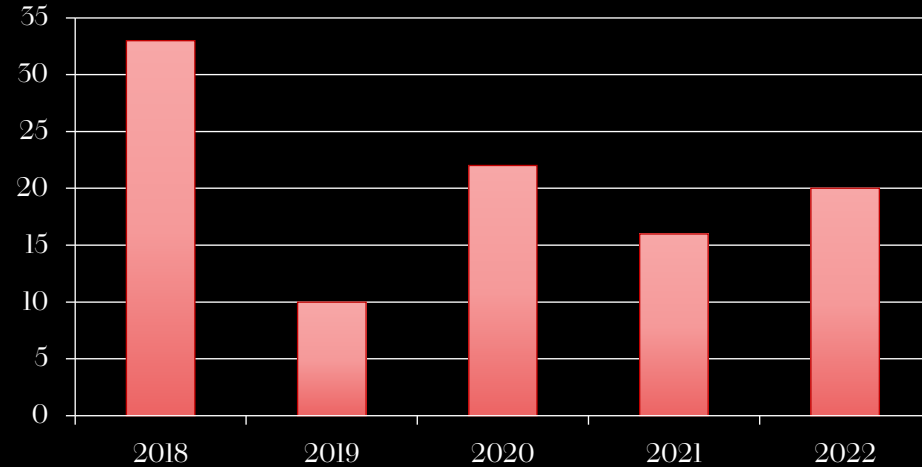

- Burglary and Larceny are both related to Organized Retail Theft.
- Organized Retail Theft is becoming more and more common.
- Organized Retail Theft is when a single individual or group shoplifts thousands of dollars in merchandise and then converts the stolen items into cash.

What is “a normal law enforcement activity” ?

Motor Vehicle Theft



- Most stolen vehicles are recovered within 72 hours.
- The most common vehicles stolen are Honda Civics / Accords and Ford F250 trucks.
- Most vehicles are used for transportation and shelter.

CCSO is dispatched to a call every 11 minutes

CCSO reports a violent crime every 7 hours

CCSO reports a property crime every 2 hours

CCSO takes 1 DUI report every 2 Days
