At the hearing, you may also submit written comments, maps, photos, graphics, or other relevant evidence, for the record.
- 2. Attend virtually via Webex (by phone or computer/mobile device). If providing spoken testimony, follow directions provided by staff and speak during the public comment portion of the hearing. The Webex link, phone number, and details on how to provide testimony via Webex will be posted to the Planning Commission meetings webpage at least one week prior to the meeting at www.clark.wa.gov/pc
- 3. **To submit written comments prior to the hearing**: Sonja.wiser@clark.wa.gov or via US Postal Service to the Clark County Planning Commission, c/o Sonja Wiser, PO Box 9810, Vancouver, WA 98666-9810. Written comments should include full name, address, city, zip code, and phone number to be included as parties of record. Staff would appreciate receiving comments at least 24 hours before the hearing to ensure that it is forwarded to the

Planning Commissioners by the hearing. Submittals for the record may, however, be made up to and during the hearing.

- 4. You may submit items like maps, photos, graphics, articles, legal history, etc., to become part of the record of the county's decision. To do so, you must provide the item. Hand it to staff at the meeting, attach it to your digital testimony, or physically send it via USPS or a delivery service that will get it to the county before the meeting. Referring to an item, sending a link to an item, or showing an item during testimony without giving it to staff, for example, would not enter an item into the record.
- 5. **If you prefer to watch and listen only**: Livestream from your personal computer at <u>www.cvtv.org</u> or broadcast cable channel 23.

Clark County Community Planning is proposing a new section of code to site Essential Public Facilities: A proposal to add a new code section, 40.260.077 Essential Public Facilities, that will create a process to site essential public facilities. This will include amendments to the following existing sections and chapters: 40.100.070 Definitions; 40.510.030 Type III Process-Quasi-Judicial Decisions, and 40.510.05 Application Submittal Requirements. Chapters that would be cross referenced and updated are, 40.210 Resource and Rural Districts; 40.220 Urban Residential Districts; 40.230 Commercial, Business, Mixed Use and Industrial Districts; and 40.250 Overlay Districts.
