	QUESTION	ANSWER
1.	Is the County able to share the available budget for this project?	<p>The county will be paying for this project with a climate planning grant from the Department of Commerce. The county is eligible for \$800,000. These funds can be used for implementation planning related to HB 1181 in addition to development of the county's Climate Element. As such, the county is interested in not spending all of its grant funds on this project. We are requesting that proposals provide consultants' best estimate of the cost of the scope of work. We expect to use the contract negotiation period with the preferred consultant(s) to weigh the tradeoffs of the scope of work and costs. Similarly, each city noted in the RFP is eligible for grant funds from the Department of County, for varying amounts related to size and legislative requirements.
