Solid Waste Program Updates: Feb. 2024 - Apr. 2024

Operations

- Hired Amanda Zodrow for Program Assistant position. Starting date: May 1, 2024
 - Will eventually be helping out with SWAC functions
- Currently working on residential yard debris collection RFP for unincorporated parts of county and cities who sign onto the contract via interlocal agreements.
 - Yard debris collection RFP will be released July 31st and has an intended contract start date of January 1st, 2025.
- Residue study has begun and will have five sorts from various single and multifamily routes (April-May) with our contractor PSU Community Environmental Services.
- Finalizing RFP for waste characterization study, to be released 5/22.
- Three HHW collection events happening April-June, in Ridgefield, Yacolt, and La Center
 - o In preparation, team members have done site visits, HAZWOPER, First Aid/CPR/AED, and other various trainings as applicable
- Working with various county departments on compost procurement reporting to ensure compliance with mandated compost procurement reporting due to Ecology each year.
- Continued working on CSWMP updates, including appendices.
 - Continuing to work with Ecology on Guidelines Rejuvenation and Modernization (GRAM) committee.
 - Also meeting with UTC as we are working with them to pilot the new condensed cost questionnaire for updated plan.

- Set up two new 65-gallon organics carts, diverting 15,600 lbs. of food waste
