

The Parks and Lands division will seek approval from Council to adopt the updated Capital Improvement Plan (CIP)(attached).

Staff is seeking feedback from the PAB for on the DRAFT CIP for the current fiscal year capital budget and the forecasted capital plan through 2030. This is the inaugural process that forecasts spending in the 6-year CIP which will be revised annually for consideration and adoption through the County's annual budgeting process.

A public comment period is underway and will be closing on August 6, 2024.
