	QUESTION	ANSWER
1.	Would the County consider extending the proposal due date to Friday, August 23, 2024? With Answers to Questions being provided on Friday, August 16 and the due date of Wednesday, Aug 21, that gives us very little time to incorporate new information into our proposal and no time to react to a late deliver or mis-directed shipment by FedEx.	<p>Q&A's are not substantial changes of work, just clarifications. The last date for Q&A is August 14, 2024.</p> <p>August 16th is the date we would issue an official RFP addendum if needed.</p> <p>An addendum is released if and when a substantial change or impact to the work requirements in the proposal is required, and we would automatically extend the proposal deadline in the addendum paperwork.</p> <p>As stated in the RFP documents, make sure to check the official RFP website page throughout the RFP timeline for updates to the Q&A and any possible addendum releases.</p> <p>https://clark.wa.gov/internal-services/request-proposal-1</p>
2.	Regarding the 50-page limit, would the County consider also excluding the Cyber-Security Questionnaire?	The Cyber-Security Questionnaire is not counted as part of the 50-pages.
