## Program Services

1. Case Management – Healthcare Provider Coordination
2. Case/Client Family Relations
3. Environmental Lead Investigation (i.e. home visit)
4. Education & Guidance on Lead Exposure Prevention

## XRF Analyzer

Finding Hidden Sources of Toxic Lead Exposure

- Speed
- Cost-Efficiency
- Non-Destructiveness



# Lead Poisoning Prevention

## Contaminated Cookware

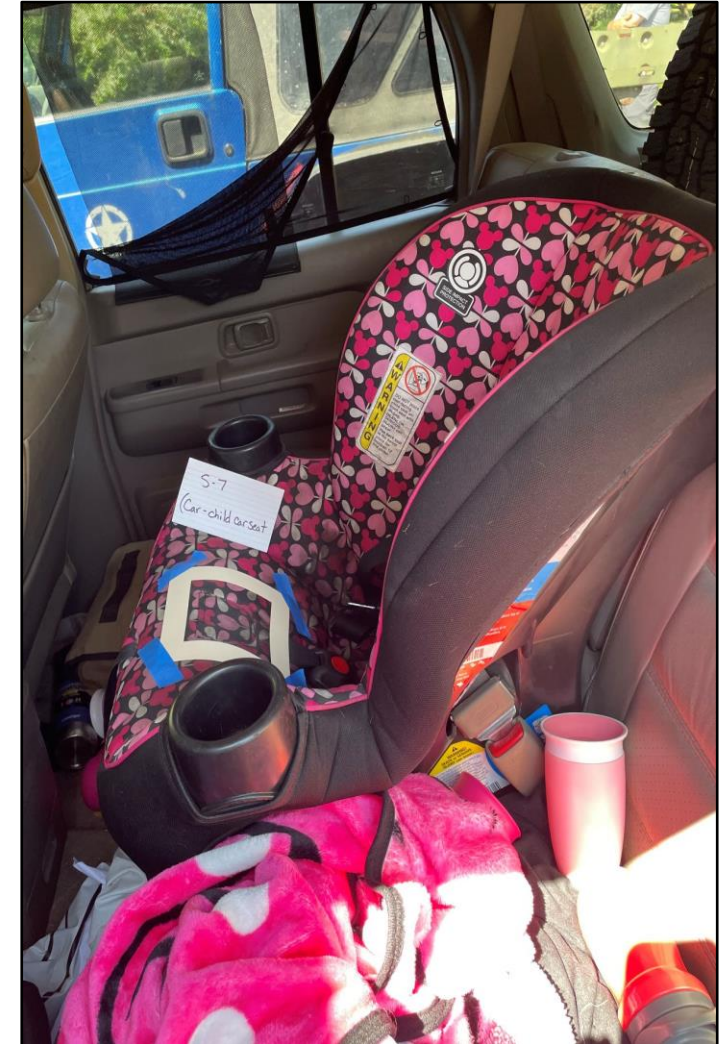
- High lead in tava (flat pan)
- High lead in pot
- High lead in new cookware



# Lead Poisoning Prevention

## Contaminated Clothing

- Lead dust on work clothing
- Lead dust in dryer lint
- Lead dust in car
- Lead dust on child car seat



# Lead Poisoning Prevention

## Contaminated Dishware

- Lead in eating bowl
- Lead in pizza tray
