Finding Hidden Sources of Toxic Lead Exposure

- Speed
- Cost-Efficiency
- Non-Destructiveness







#### **Contaminated Cookware**

- High lead in tava (flat pan)
- High lead in pot
- High lead in new cookware













#### **Contaminated Clothing**

- Lead dust on work clothing
- Lead dust in dryer lint
- Lead dust in car
- Lead dust on child car seat











#### **Contaminated Dishware**

- Lead in eating bowl
- Lead in pizza tray
