On Friday, July 26th, 2024, at 9:00 AM Clark County Historic Preservation Commission members Andrew Gregg and Morgan Frazier, and two staff members (Mark Person of the City of Vancouver and Bart Catching of Clark County) joined community volunteers for a site visit and tour at the Historic John Stanger House at 9215 SE Evergreen Highway, Vancouver, Washington.
