## VoteWA discrepancy explanation

One voter had both their original and replacement ballot counted.

One voter had a ballot accepted where someone had forged their siganture on the envelope as confirmed by the canvassing board. Pursuant to WAC 434-261-053(6) the voter attested they did not cast that ballot and therefore were able to get and cast a replacement ballot.

Two ballots with the same label were processed and counted. One voter was issued a ballot that was labeled for a different voter and they voted and returned it. The voter later noticed they did not have a returned ballot and regusted a replacement ballot and it was counted.
