VoteWA discrepancy explanation

<p>One voter had both their original and replacement ballot counted.</p> <p>-</p> <p>One voter had a ballot accepted where someone had forged their signature on the envelope as confirmed by the canvassing board. Pursuant to WAC 434-261-053(6) the voter attested they did not cast that ballot and therefore were able to get and cast a replacement ballot.</p> <p>-</p> <p>Two ballots with the same label were processed and counted. One voter was issued a ballot that was labeled for a different voter and they voted and returned it. The voter later noticed they did not have a returned ballot and requested a replacement ballot and it was counted.</p>
