County Activities - Kevin Tyler

- Bridge Repair Updates
 - o Finished bridge 6 and 25, bridge 23 is 99% complete, repairs on bridge 18 and 20 have been ongoing
- Railroad Roadbed Rehab Status
 - Putting out contract for rehab work in early January
 - Some rehab work up near Yacolt
 - Some painting of Hwy 99 bridge and then bridges on the south line will go to PVJR
 - Areas for work with money left over were based on where BYCX is operating, near Yacolt and as far south as the money will take us, Kevin and Randy will discuss offline
