



CLARK COUNTY MENTAL HEALTH SALES TAX FUNDING ADVISORY BOARD MEETING MINUTES OF OCTOBER 10, 2024

October, 2024

The Clark County Mental Health Sales Tax Funding Advisory Board convened on October 10, 2024 via Microsoft Teams.

3:00pm

The advisory board held a final discussion about the external proposals for mental health sales tax funding based on the submitted proposals and subsequent dialogue, interviews, and review. Based on that discussion, the board voted to recommend that the county council fund the following external organization's proposals for MHST funding:

1. Girls Inc. of the Pacific Northwest
2. Recovery Café of Clark County (recommendation to only 9 recovery coaches)
3. Family Solutions
4. Fosterful
5. Friends of the Children SWWA
6. YWCA – Therapeutic/Support for Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault (excluding hotline manager position)
7. YWCA – Prevention/Early Intervention (recommendation to only fund circle of security parenting classes)
8. Pier 360
9. Community Roots Collaborative
10. 4D Recovery
11. Housing Initiative LLC
12. Janus Youth
13. Boys and Girls Club SWWA

14. Lifeline Connections (recommendation to fund only 1 year of program)

The board then revisited Jail Service's internal request. Based upon clarification since Jail Services' prior presentation and positive legal review indicating these funds can be used for BH-specific corrections officers to support treatment delivery, the board voted to recommend funding of all the positions requested by the jail in 2025. These positions are:

- Jail transition coordinator x2
- Lead jail transition coordinator
- Reentry support specialist iii
- Mental health implementation coordinator
- Medicaid implementation coordinator
- MOUD officer x6
- Reentry officer x4
