1.	We would like to formally request a two-week extension on the deadline	We are on a very tight schedule for the RFP and the completion of the project and will not be able to extend the February 19 submission deadline.
2.	What is the purpose of the public involvement component of this study?	The purpose of the public involvement component of the study is to address WAC365-190-040(8)(a) Public Participation Program.
3.	As prospective/current mining companies have more access to site specific information, how involved should the mining companies be in the process of the study and engagement?	Mining companies should be involved to the extent needed as they likely have more proprietary information about the degree and availability of mineral lands on certain properties.
4.	Is the purpose for community involvement: 1 - to ensure that impacted stakeholders are aware of the project? 2 - to give folks an opportunity to influence the report/work? 3- what is the role of stakeholder in making recommendations of each resource land type? 4 - how do they want to use this product?	See response to 2 above.
5.	How does Clark County want to use this product?	This product will be used as an input to the comprehensive plan periodic update to help inform decision makers on whether any changes are warranted to our existing resource designations.
