# Background

- Periodically staff "batch" minor amendments to the Clark County Code for Council's consideration.
- Proposed changes include:
  - Correction of scrivener's errors;
  - Updated references;
  - Clarifying of standards; and
  - Proposed minor policy changes.
- These batches of code changes are commonly known as "Biannual Code Amendments."



### Process

- Gather proposed updates from prior Council direction, staff, DEAB, and customer suggestions
- Prepare preliminary draft updates
- Council work session on 2/19 approval to proceed
- Review with DEAB on 3/6 recommendation to Council
- 60-day notice to Commerce for Title 40 updates
- Legal review of final draft of updates
- SEPA review and threshold determination
- Planning Commission work session and hearing for Title 40 updates – TBD
- Council Hearing(s) for proposed adoption TBD



# **Overview of Non-policy Changes**

#### Title 32

• Gender neutral references to responsible parties

### Title 40

- Type II/III timelines for application holds under new state law
- Time limit for expenditure of impact fee revenue per state law
- Urban ADU standards consistent with state law
- Clarify language allowing townhouses in Low Density Districts without a Planned Unit Development.
- Clarify School Impact Fee Calculation Methods



# **Summary of Proposed Minor Policy Changes**

#### Title 40

- Rural light and glare standards for new development
- Forest Practices code update
- Temporary Hardship allowance to use existing permanent structures
- Street adjacent off-street parking for middle housing

#### Title 6

• Late fee for overdue Fire Marshal invoices



# **Forest Practices Ordinance 40.260.080**

- Reviewed for consistency against the following state and county codes:
  - Related sections of Title 40
  - County critical areas ordinances
  - Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 76.09 Forest Practices
  - Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 222-16 concerning forestland conversions



# **Forest Practices Ordinance 40.260.080**

Recommended code changes:

- Add provisions for issuance of class I forest practices permits currently absent from the code
- Update code language for consistency with RCW 76.09, WAC 222-16, and critical areas ordinances
- Develop a clear list of exemptions from permit requirement
- Update provisions for class IV general (conversion) and conversion option harvest plans to be consistent with Title 40
- Update title 6 to consolidate class I and site inspection fees
