What's happening?

A new restroom and shelter building is being constructed on the farm that will serve farm users and future improved public access. A farm access trail concept is being developed that will lead to future development of a trail from the wetland to Hazel Dell Community park.

When and how long?

Shelter Design: Summer 2025 - Spring 2026

Shelter installation: Summer - Fall 2026

Trail concept design: Summer 2025 - Winter 2025/6

What can I expect when the project is done?

- **A new combination restroom building and shelter including:**
 - Restroom for farm users
 - Shelter space for farm programming and potential for reserveable public space.
 - Restroom for public use to support future trail.
- **A trail concept plan for future funding and development.**
