1.	Page 1. Jacobs would like to confirm that no hard copies are required for submission. The submission materials are to be submitted via (1) USB.	Correct. No hard copies and only electronic submissions.
2.	Page 18. Project Team section. Jacobs would like clarification about the request for a legal team to advise on compliance with applicable laws and regulations. Jacobs would like to confirm the request is for a technical team led by an expert in laws and regulations related to solid waste and environmental operations who can provide guidance, and not legal representation for this project.	We expect the project team to include licensed legal counsel, not solely a legal subject matter expert, to ensure all legal advice and decisions are made by a qualified attorney authorized to practice law. This legal counsel will NOT be representing Clark County, but will support the recommendations of the project team.
3.	Page 32. Proof of Insurance. Jacobs would like to clarify the requirement to list Clark County as additional insured. Does the requirement include auto, commercial general liability, and professional liability or just auto and commercial general liability?	This page is part of the attached SAMPLE contract.
