	QUESTION	ANSWER
1.	The RFP references a SBE goal but not a set amount. Is there a small business goal on this project?	This project does not have a mandatory consultant DBE goal, but documentation of voluntary ten (10) percent SBE efforts will be required. (See Addendum #1)
	If yes, would a DBE certified firm satisfy this goal?	Yes, a DBE certified firm would satisfy this goal.
2.	We wanted to confirm who would be providing the survey services. In the introduction it looked like the consultant would be responsible but under "County Performed Work" it lists survey.	The County will provide survey services for this project.
3.	Would it be possible to see the existing geotechnical report?	The reference to "existing geotechnical documentation" in the RFP was an error; the County does not have any existing geotechnical information for this site. We anticipate that geotechnical investigation and recommendations will be required as part of this project.
4.	What is the County's working relationship with adjacent landowners north and south of the ROW, and what is the feasibility of TCEs for the project if required?	If Temporary Construction Easements are required, the County will obtain them.
5.	Would a cover letter count towards the 10-page limit?	The coversheet (Attachment A), debarment form (Attachment C), and resumes are excluded from the 10-page limit. An additional formal cover letter would count towards the 10-page limit.
