Background

- Cougar Creek Greenway
- Property owner Clark County Public Works (Parks and Clean Water)
- Seeking project planning, engineering design, and permitting services
- Project Target:
 - Phase 1: 90% PS&E
 - Phase 2 (contingent): Final PS&E + bid package
- Anticipated funding available = \$210,000 (P1 = \$175,000; P2 = \$35,000)

Project elements

- Floodplain reconnection
- Habitat enhancement wetland and riparian
- Infrastructure protection
- Native plantings
- Trail corridor



Scope

Phase 1:

- Project management
- Project planning and coordination
- Project Design Report
- Permitting support from preparation until permits are acquired, including Cultural and Environmental reviews.
- · 90% engineering design, specifications and engineer's cost estimate

Phase 2 (contingent):

- 100% engineering design, specifications and engineer's cost estimate
- Bid package suitable for Clark County competitive procurement process
- 60% design 2020
- Stakeholders include: Clean Water, Parks and Nature, Lands Management, General public; Clark Regional Wastewater District






Figure 1. Cougar 3 project area locator map, showing approximate project area extent and Cougar Creek OHW.
