 - The system is struggling to meet the needs, primarily due to limited capacity
 - Several barriers and gaps exist to provide adequate support
 - The anticipated needs to fulfill current goals
 - Potential impacts with the future Federal Landscape
 - What recommendations were given by the Focus Group
- Homeless System Evaluation/Analysis – *ECHO Membership*
 - Diana Perez and Jamie Spinelli went over the Draft 2.0 of the Systems Analysis Proposal and its changes.
