

## How to Respond to a Divorce

You were served with divorce papers  
 You do **NOT** agree with the items in the Petition  
 There **ARE** children of the marriage

### Step 1: Determine your response deadline

20 days if you were served in person in the State of Washington

60 days if you were served outside the State of Washington

90 days if you were served by mail

Forms may be downloaded for free at [www.courts.wa.gov/forms](http://www.courts.wa.gov/forms) or you may purchase them at the Clerk's Office

### Step 2: Fill out these forms and make copies

### Step 3: Copies Needed

Original is to be filed with the Clerk

1 copy for your records

1 copy to give to the other party

### Step 4: Take your original forms to the Clerk's Office to file

## Step 5: Provide copies to other party

You may deliver or mail documents yourself.

This means that they receive a copy of what you have filed. It does not require them to be personally served by a process server. It can be done by mail at least 10 days before the court date or in person at least 7 days before the court date.

If the other party has an attorney, deliver or mail the forms to the attorney.

### File Original with the Clerk and make a copy for your records

You have now responded to the Petition

While you are waiting for your trial if you need to have Temporary Orders (such as temporary parenting plan, child support, maintenance, temporary restraining order and or temporary orders regarding the use of property), you may request a hearing.
