

Ex-Parte: Immediate Orders

These are short term orders and are valid for only 14 days

You want to ask the court for immediate orders of:

- Temporary placement of the children
- Restraints on the other parent
- Use of property
- Other issues

Step 1: Fill out this form and make copies

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Step 2: Copies needed

Original set to file with the Clerk

1 copy for your records

1 copy to give to the other party

1 copy to the Commissioner

1 copy to the Prosecuting Attorney's Office, if you have children who have received public assistance at some point.

Step 3: Take your original forms to the Clerk's office BEFORE 11:00 a.m. on the day you want them signed. This is for the Ex-Parte Docket

Step 4: Return to court that same day at 1:00 pm.

Check the elevator to find out where the Ex Parte docket is being held.

If the court signs your paperwork, you will need to purchase a CERTIFIED copy of the Immediate Restraining Order and Hearing that you can use for service on the other party.

Payment for a certified copy is \$5.00 for the first [age and \$1.00 for each additional page.

Step 5: Serve the other party

You must give the other party a copy of the Motion. YOU CANNOT SERVE THE OTHER PARTY.

Someone over the age of 18 must serve. The person who serves your spouse must complete, sign and give back to you .

Step 6: After the other party has been served

File the ORIGINAL Proof of Personal Service form with the Clerk. Date stamp on your copy.

Step 7: Attend your court hearing
