Windows:

Permit **does not** include any other components, such as new construction, structural, increased /additional loading, etc. Additional permits required if work involves more than same size and location window replacement.

Residential

- U 30 glazing required
- Egress windows must comply with IRC310, with exception of R310.1 (window sill height) if replacing in same opening
- Window may require safety glazing per IRC 308

Commercial

- U-30 glazing required non-metal frame; U-38 metal frame fixed; U-40 metal frame operable; U-40 Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC)
- Window may require safety glazing per IBC2406
- Plans Examiner to review apartment or condominium per HB 1848
