



To ensure cost recovery for the services provided related to permits we issue, effective January 25, 2019, the plan review and inspection fees charged by the Fire Marshal's Office will increase 7.5 percent for the following permit types:

NHC, ADS and ARS – new home construction for houses over 3,600 square feet (including attached garages)

Example: Fees will increase from \$69 to \$74 (an increase of \$5)

SOL – roof-mount solar permits

Fees will increase from \$137 to \$148 (an increase of \$11)

CMN and CME – new commercial construction (commercial buildings)

Example: Construction up to 10,000 square feet
Plan review fees will increase from \$273 to \$294 (an increase of \$21)
Inspection fees will increase from \$190 to \$205 in most cases (an increase of \$15)

For projects exceeding 10,000 square feet, each additional 10,000 square feet or portion thereof

Plan review fees will increase from \$135 to \$145 (an increase of \$10)
Inspection fees will increase from \$74 to \$80 (an increase of \$6)

MFM – new multi-family building permits (apartment buildings)

Example: Apartment building with 12 dwelling units
Plan review fees will increase from \$273 to \$294 (an increase of \$21)
Inspection fees will increase from \$145 to \$156 (an increase of \$11)
