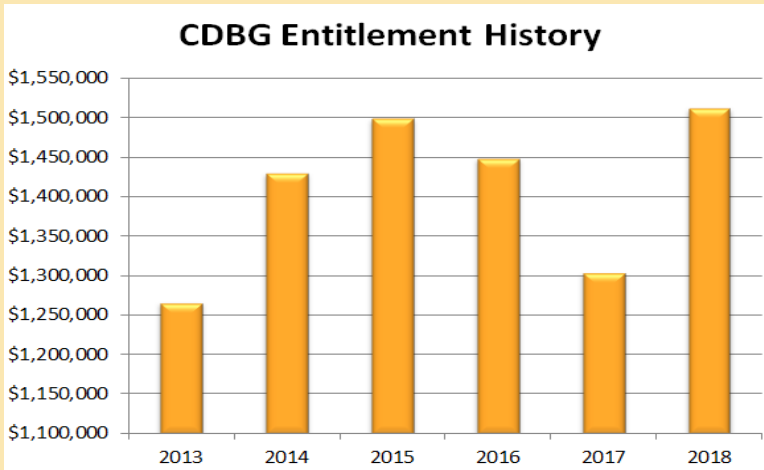


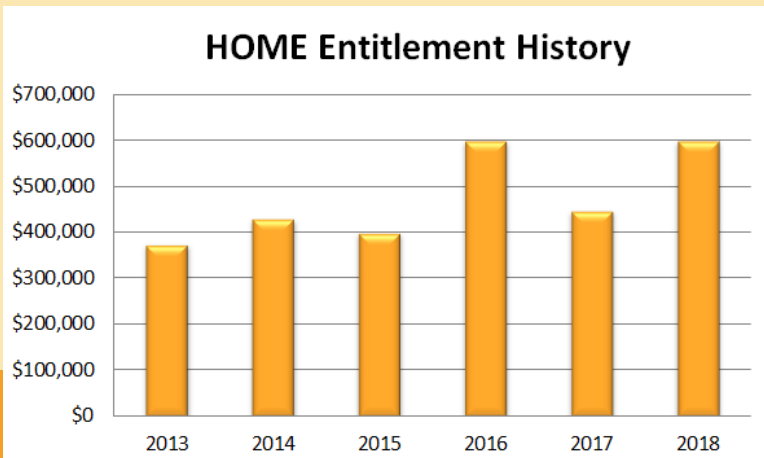
# HUD ENTITLEMENT FUNDS

Clark County administers U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships allocation.

CDBG funds are used for a variety of programs and projects that benefit low- and moderate-income county residents outside the city of Vancouver. Projects range from infrastructure improvements and economic development to homeowner rehabilitation, community facilities and fair housing activities.



HOME funds are used to provide loans and grants to homeowners, homeless service providers and nonprofit developers for acquisition and construction of affordable housing, as well as rental assistance to alleviate homelessness.



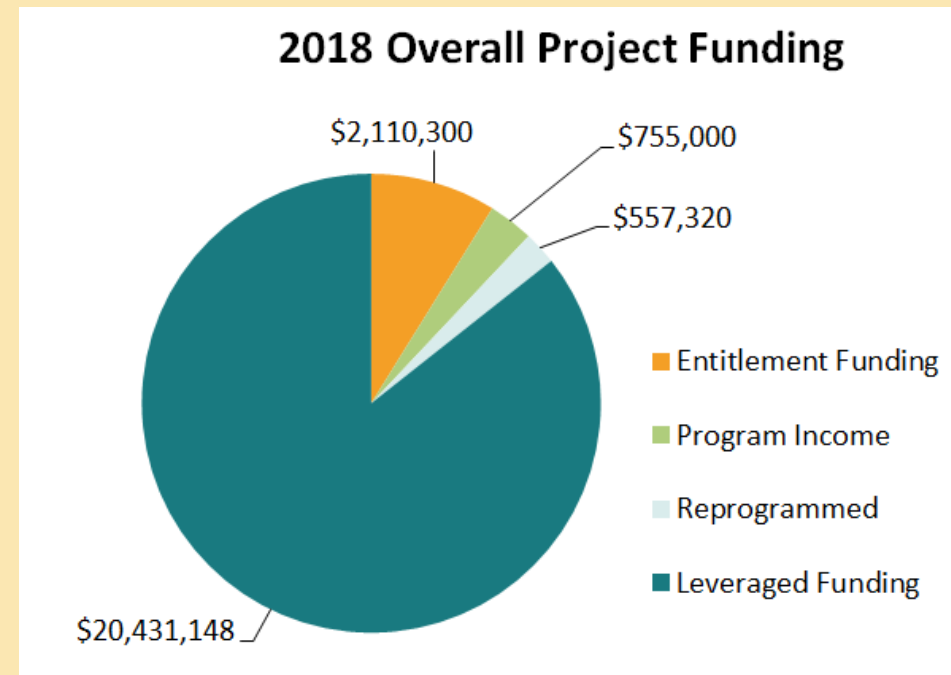
Projects are reviewed and recommended for funding by the Urban County Policy Board, an advisory board comprised of Clark County mayors and chaired by Councilor Julie Olson.

Program Year July 1, 2018 - June 30, 2019

## Projected Outcomes for 2018 Funding

- 15,638 people will have access to new or improved facilities for services
- 8,430 people will have improved neighborhoods
- 204 homeless families will be housed
- 49 new affordable rental units will be constructed
- 32 businesses will be assisted
- 16 homeowners will have safe and stable housing
- 3 new first-time buyers will purchase an affordable home
- 3 people with developmental disabilities will have safe and supportive housing
